Doing any other activities that you do with them

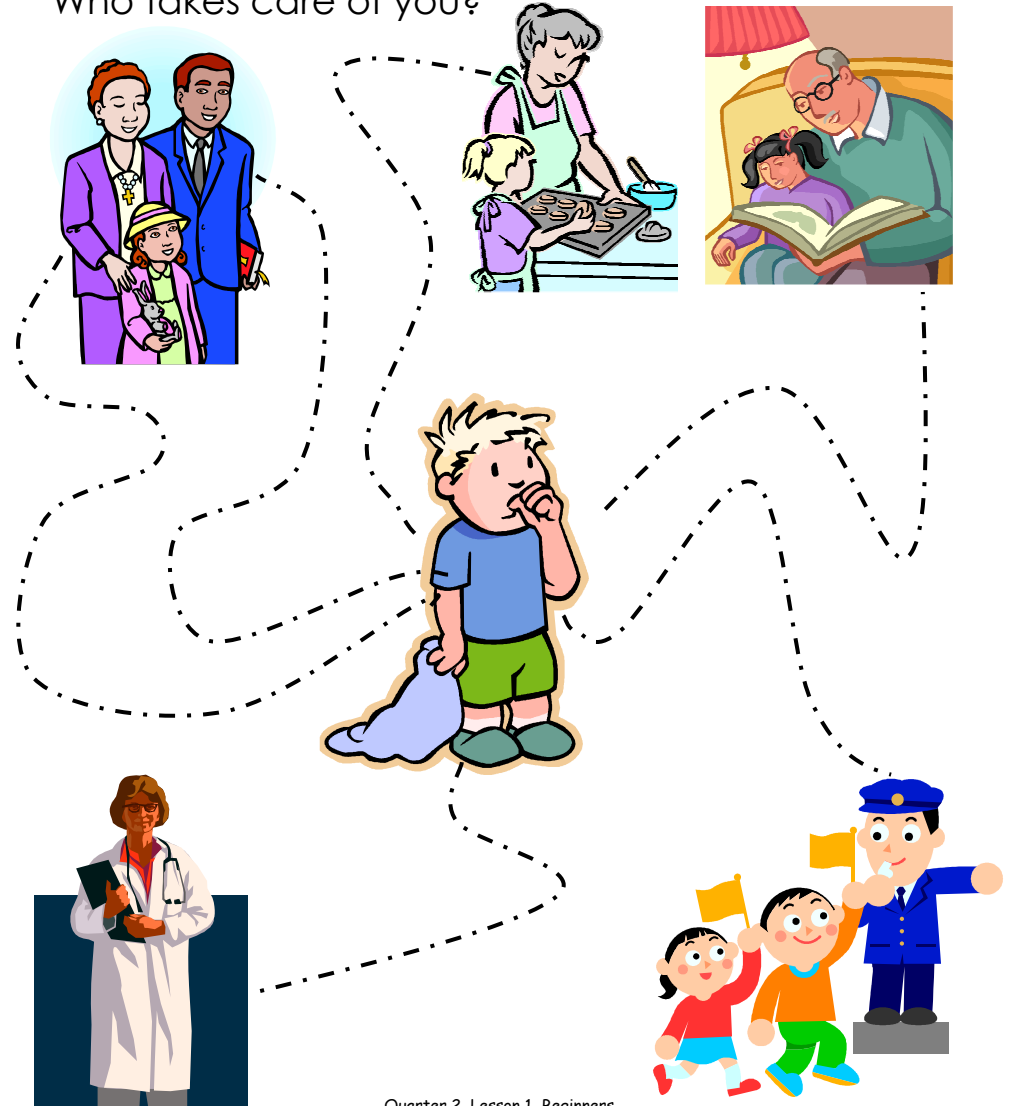
You could also make a picture book of them doing the various activities and add a picture of an angel or Jesus to each picture.

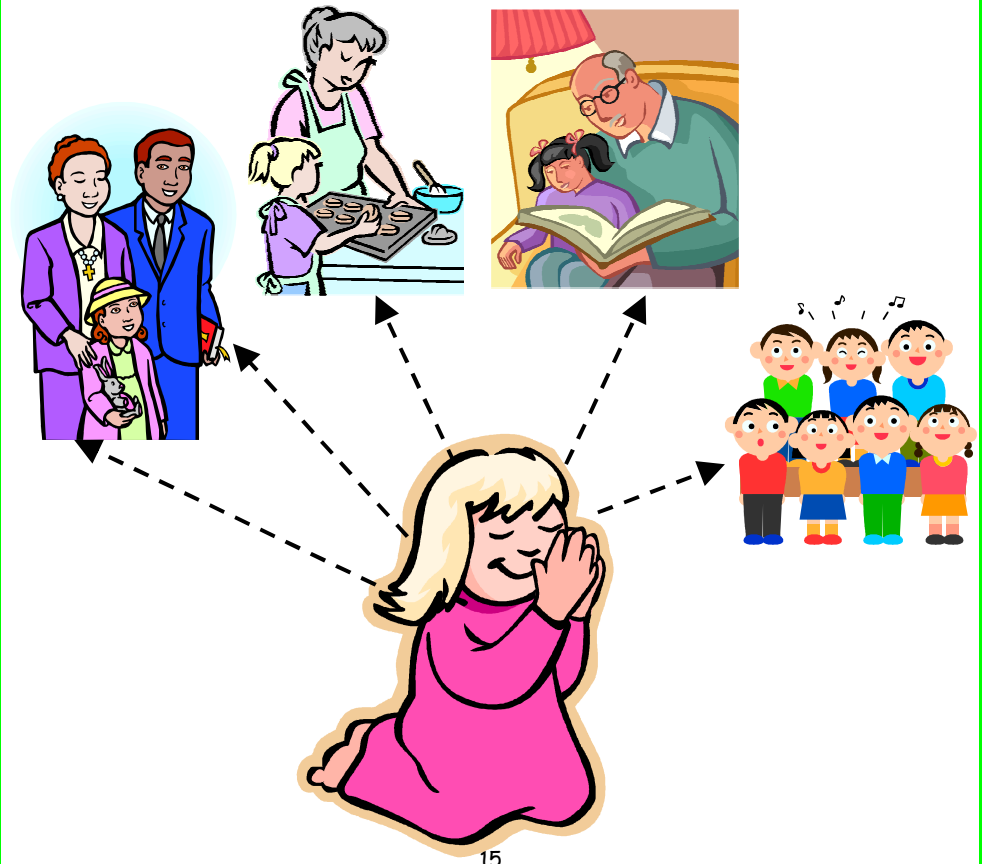

Sunday

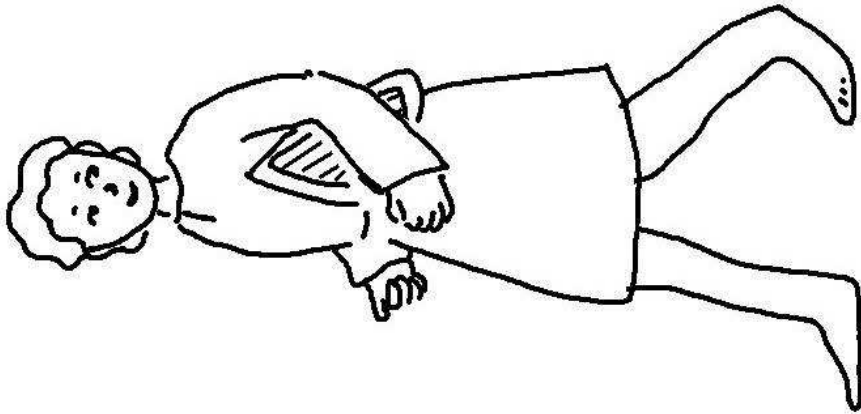

David cared for the sheep and knew their names. Jesus takes care of us and He knows our names too.

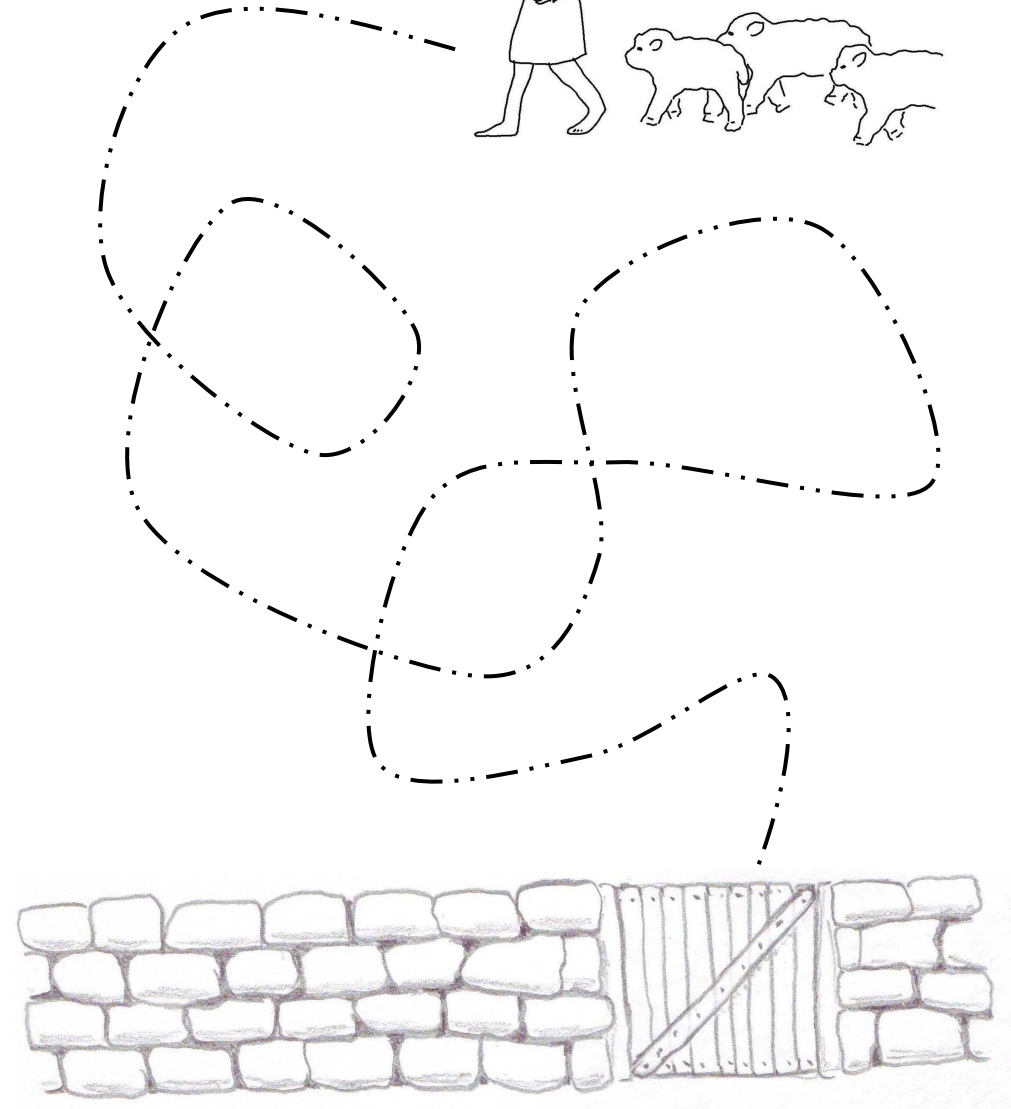
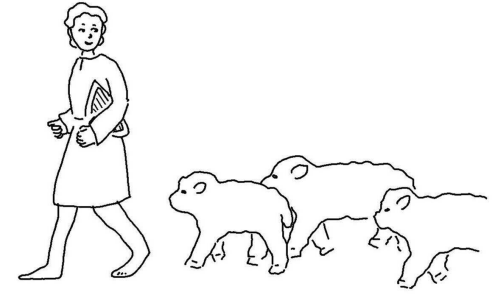
Monday

Every morning David would lead his sheep to some nice green grass.

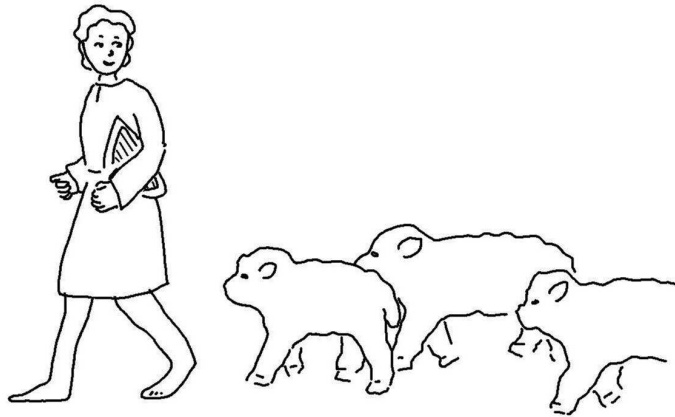


Wednesday

Late in the afternoon David will lead his sheep back to the sheepfold.



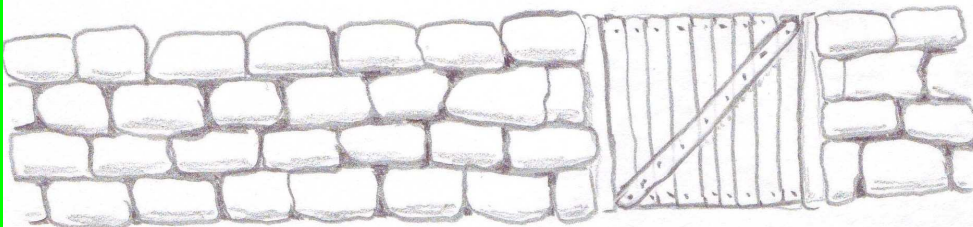
Tuesday



Late in the afternoon, David would bring his sheep back to the sheepfold. Once again he would count the sheep and make sure that they were all well.



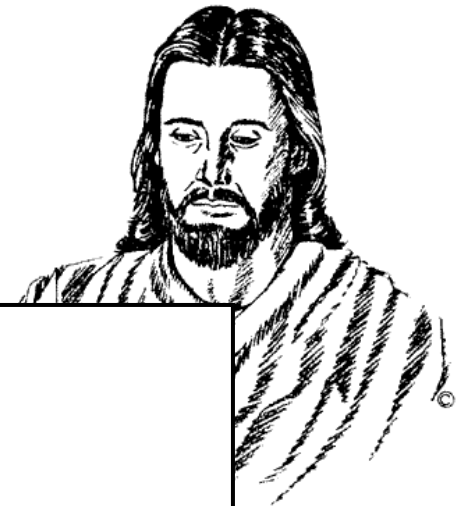
He would take care of any hurts that they had and carefully shut the gate to keep them safe through the night.

When the sheep became thirsty he would lead them to a nice quiet pool of water so that they could have a drink.

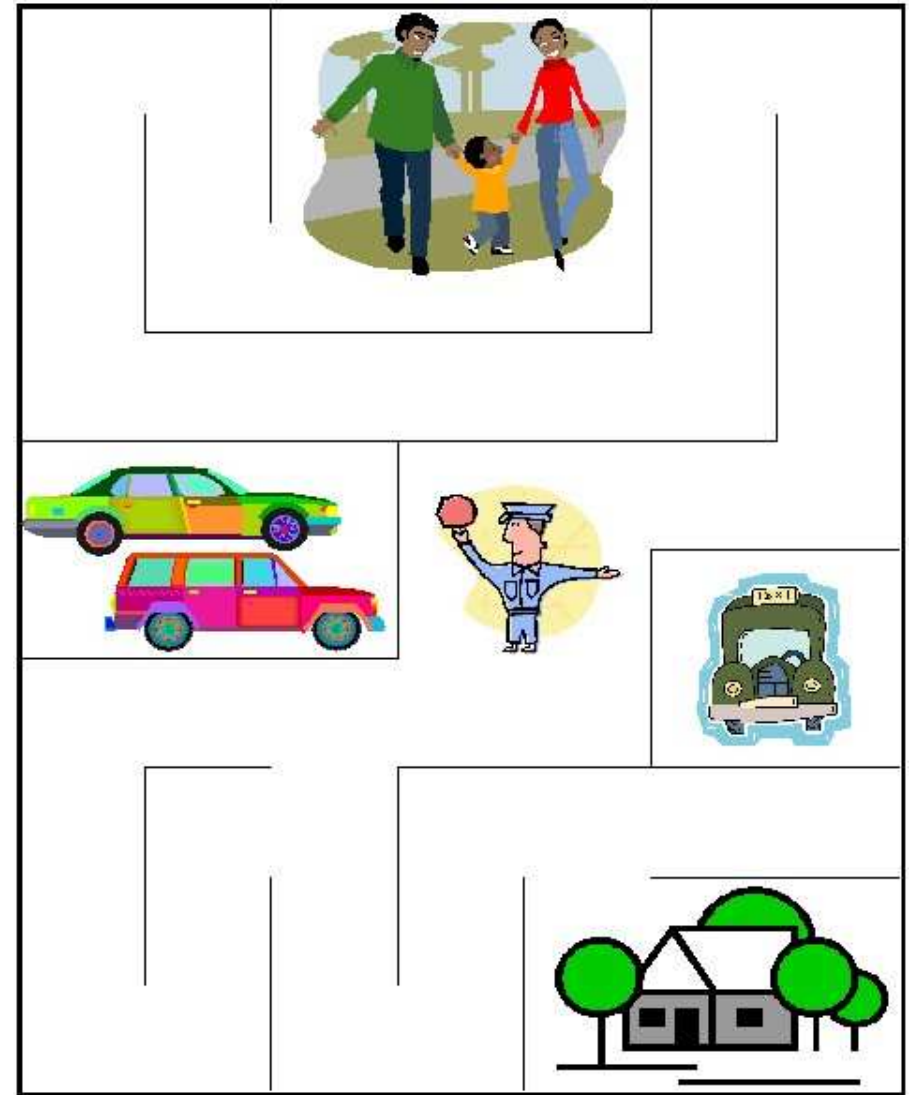

Monday

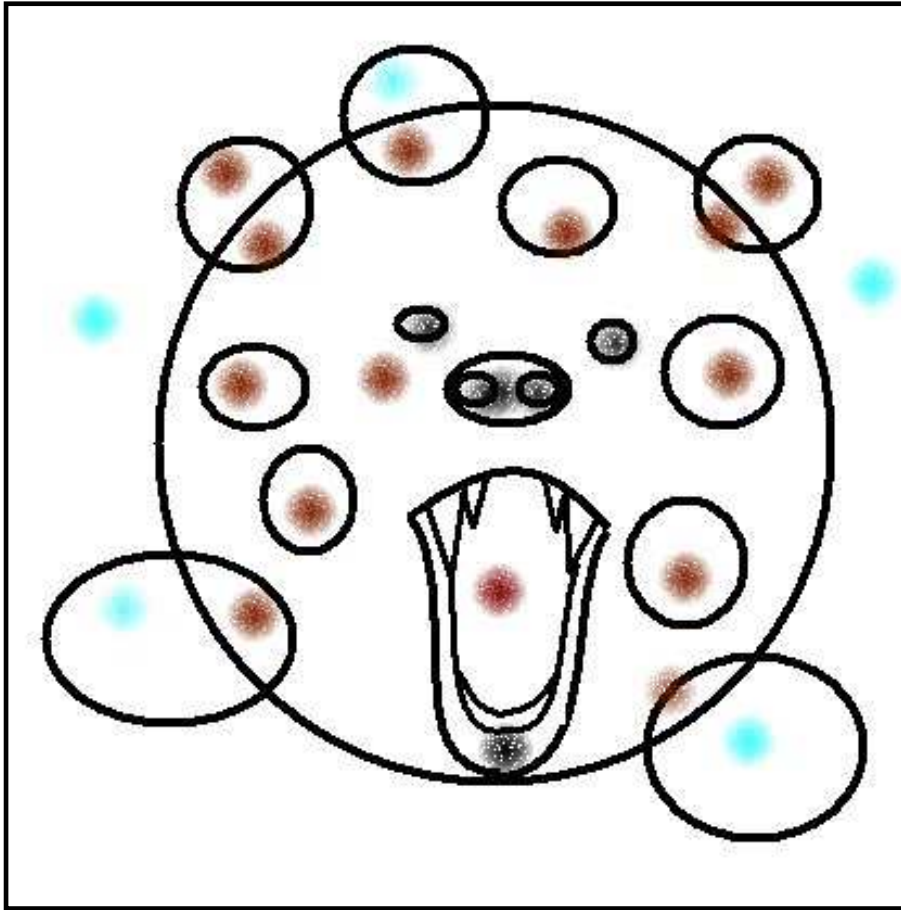
Jesus has lots of people to help keep you safe. Who will help this little boy get home safely?

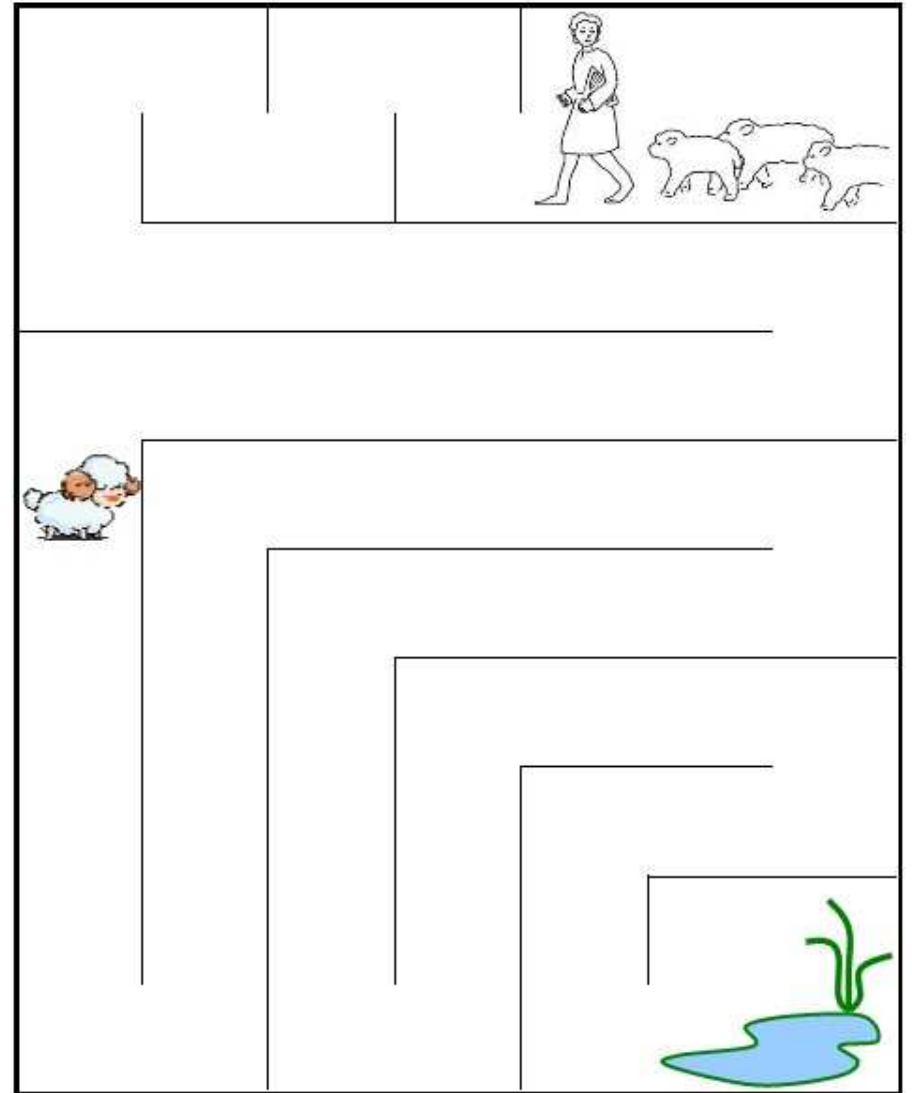
Sunday

Jesus helped David protect the lambs from the growling bear and the hungry lion.



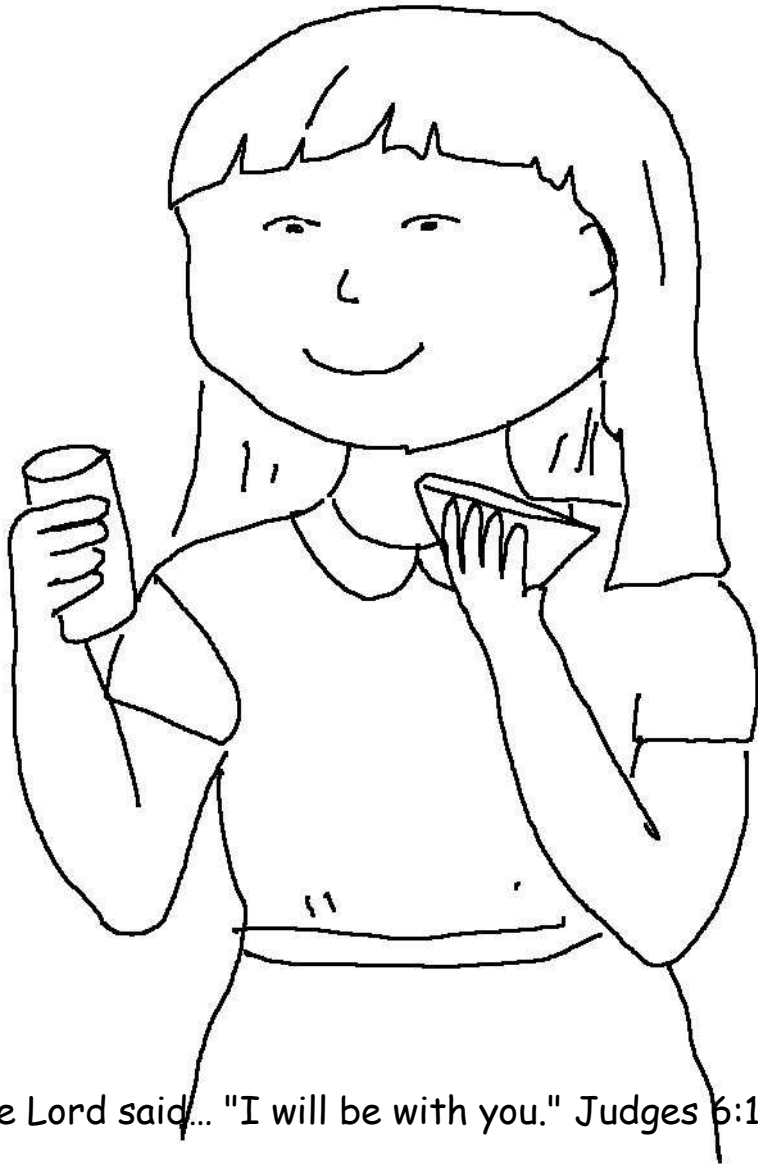
Thursday
