
## Friday

#### Sunday


Little Maid had been taken from her home to live in country far away. She missed her mummy and daddy; but she knew that God was with her. She didn't pray to the ugly stone



idols that Captain Naaman and his wife prayed to; everyday she would pray to the God in heaven.






## Wednesday

When Captain Naaman got to the prophets home, the prophet sent a man out to tell him "Go and wash in the




Jordan River seven times and you will be made well."


