
Spend time each day telling your child Bible stories and teaching them the memory verse. Spend some time each day for your own Bible Study and Prayer. If your children see you doing this they will learn how important it is in your life and how important it needs to be in theirs. You can say to them "Mummy or daddy needs to have some quiet time with Jesus. I want you to play quietly with your toys while I have my quiet time with Jesus."

You could also make them a memory verse book. Use an exercise book and write the memory verse in big letters; on the opposite page paste a picture that illustrates it. If you use the book and repeat the memory verse twice each day, you will find that by the end of the week the child has become familiar with the verse. When the child is old enough to repeat it after you, have them say it each time. Once a week repeat all the verses from the beginning of the book to where you are up too. (As a bonus, this will enhance their academic abilities when they get to school.)

We can be like Daniel and show others that we love Jesus when we do the right thing.




Sunday

We can talk to Jesus in the morning when we wake up, at lunch time, and in the evening just before we go to bed, just like Daniel did.










The king sent messengers all over the country to tell about God. Find paths from the city to each of the towns.

The king sent out messengers all over the country. This time they told the people that the king wanted them to worship and pray to the Living God in Heaven who had protected Daniel while he was in the lions den.


God can protect us just as He protected Daniel in the lions den.

God can help us to do the right thing; just like he helped Daniel to do the right thing.









angel to shut the lions' mouths so that they couldn't hurt him.


When we put God first and pray to Him everyday, God will send His angels to watch over us too.




