Desire of Ages p. 342-348

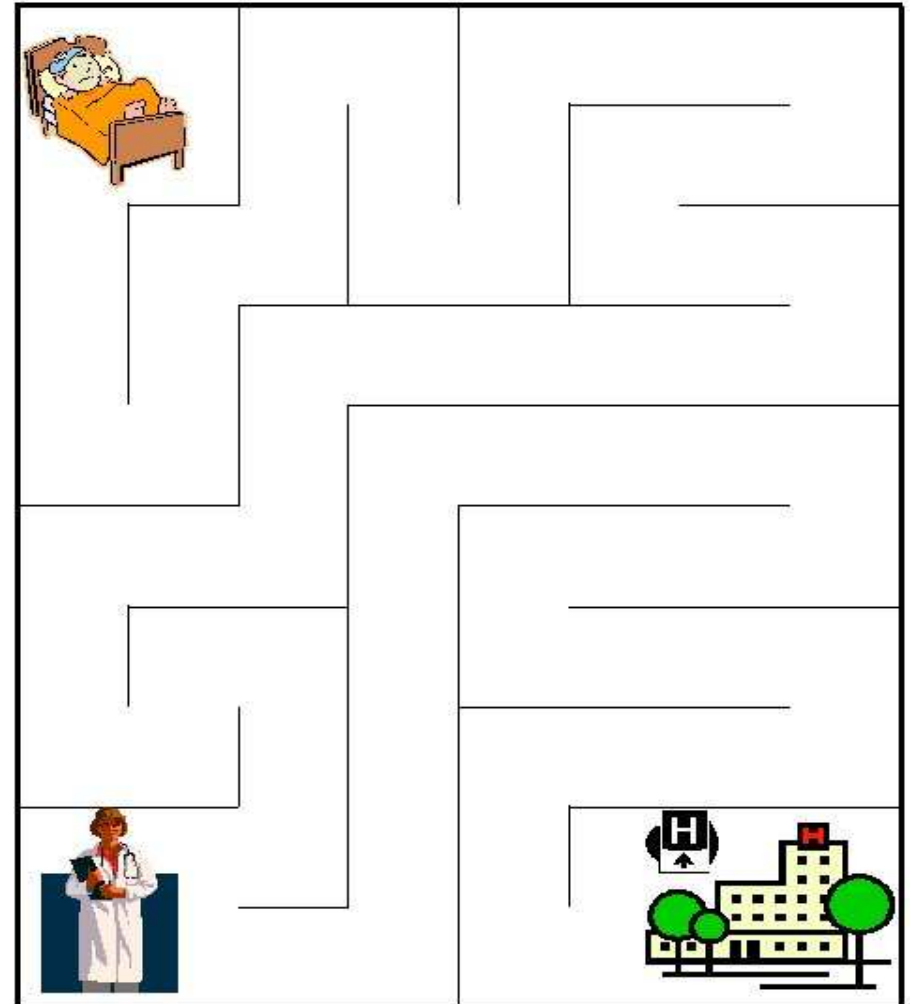

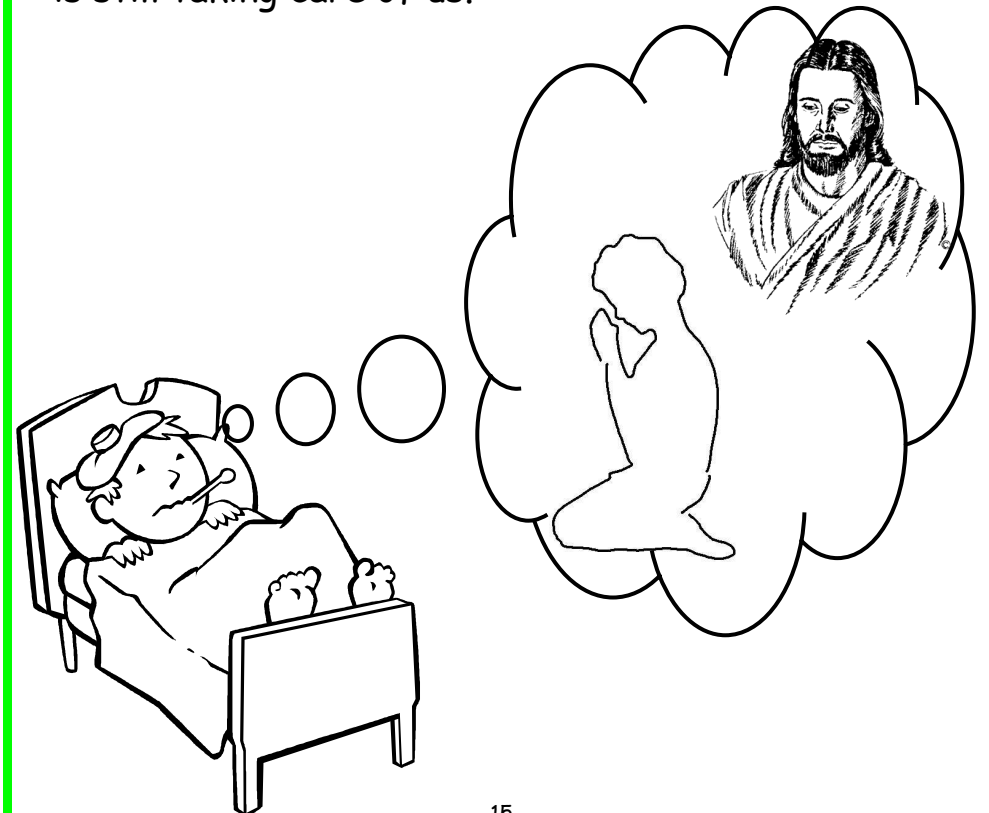
Friday

Sometimes He says "Yes," sometimes He says "No," and sometimes He says "Wait awhile."

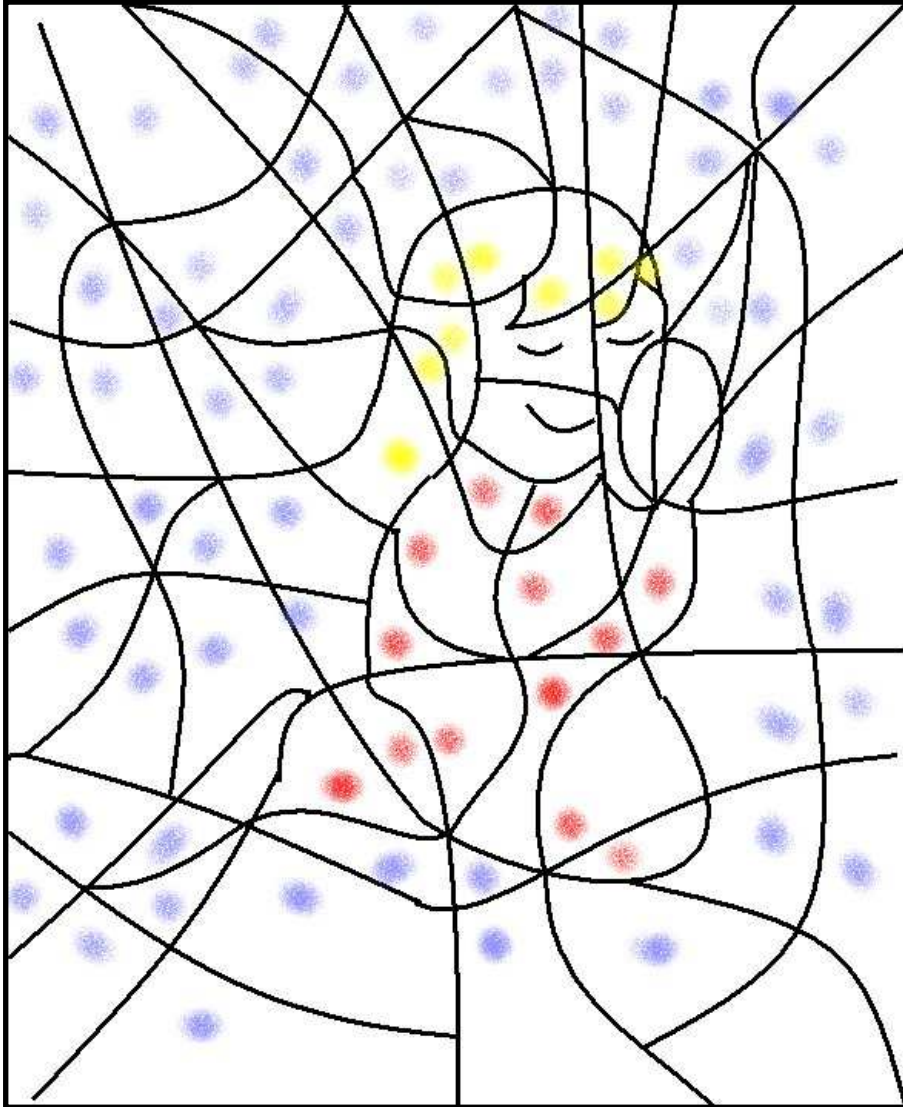
We need to always remember to say thankyou to Jesus for our healthy bodies, for being able to crawl, run, play and make sounds.

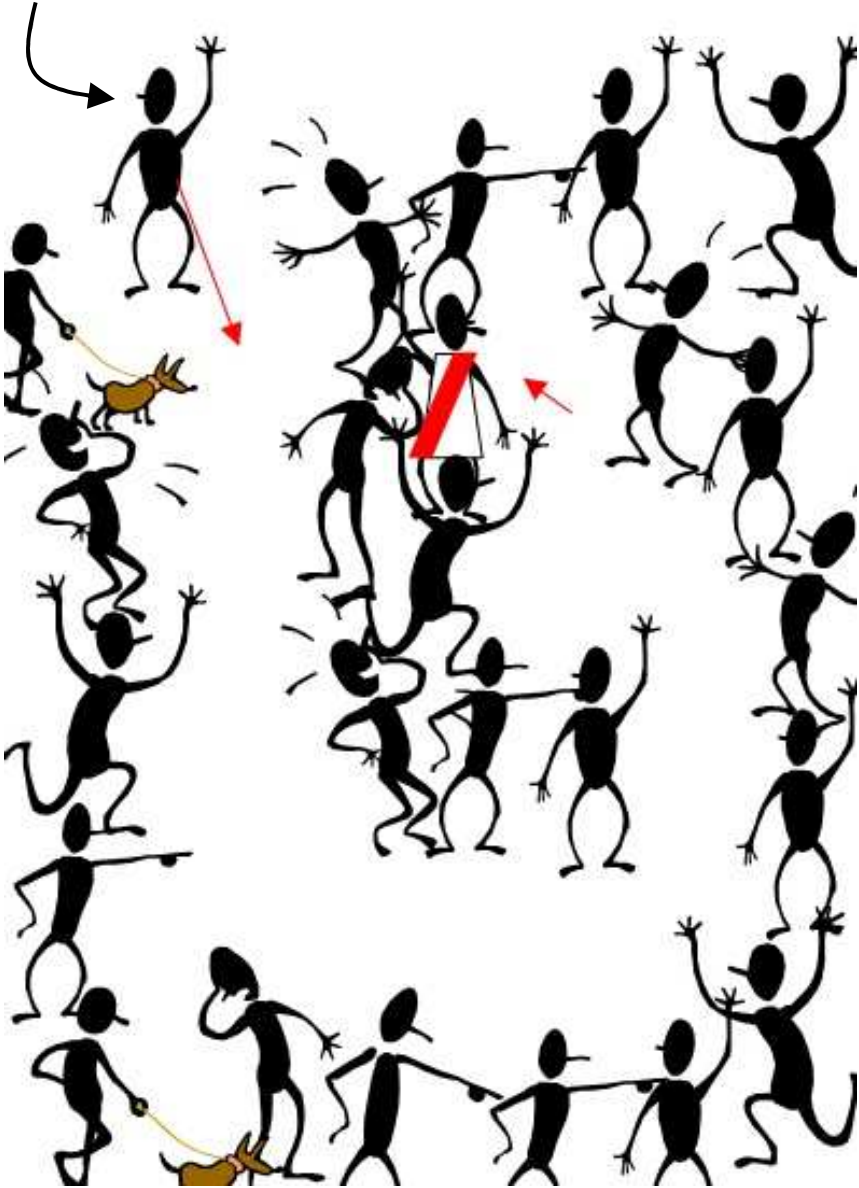
Jesus started following Jairus to his house but there were so many people who wanted Jesus' help; Jesus kept stopping to say some kind words to them or to make them well.

Jesus wants to help us each day just as He helped the people back then.



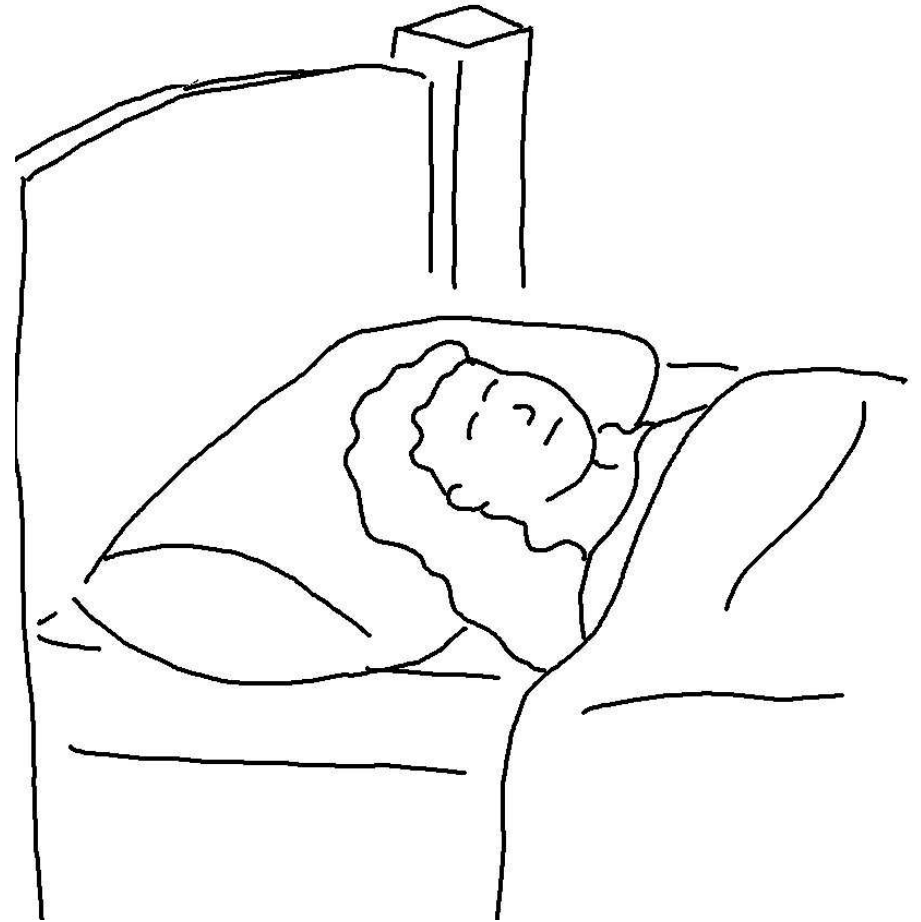
Monday

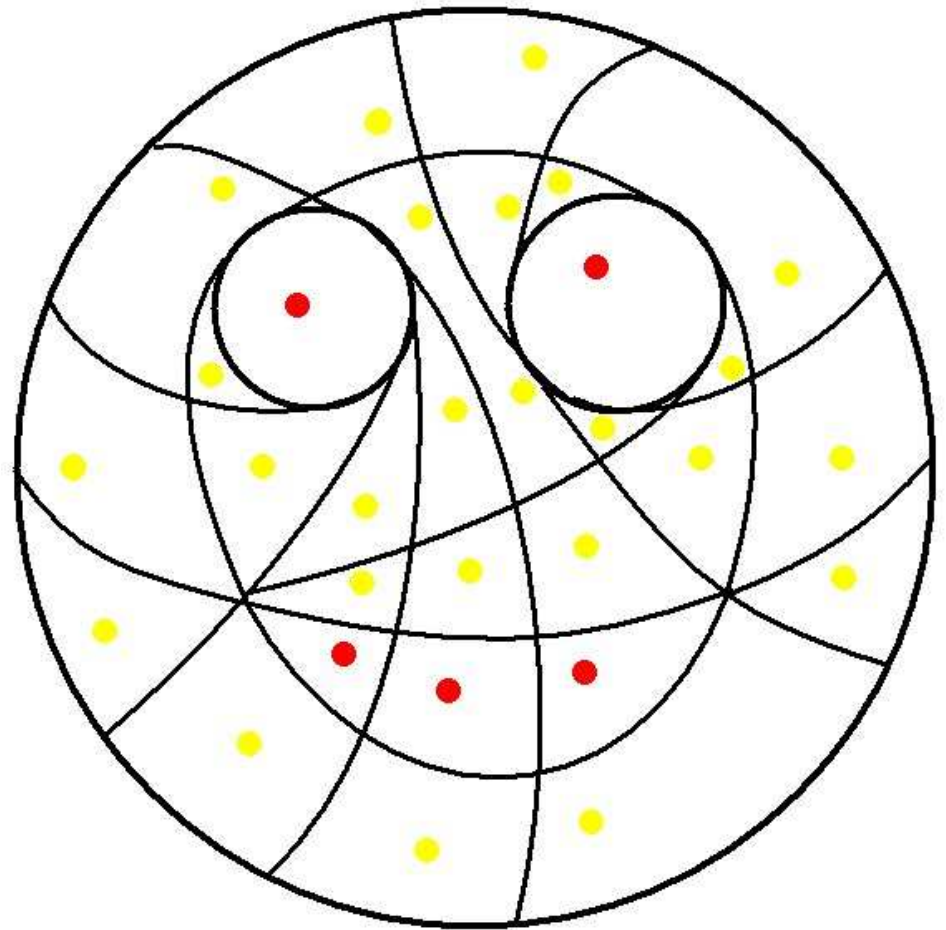


I'm sure the little girl and her family said thankyou to Jesus.

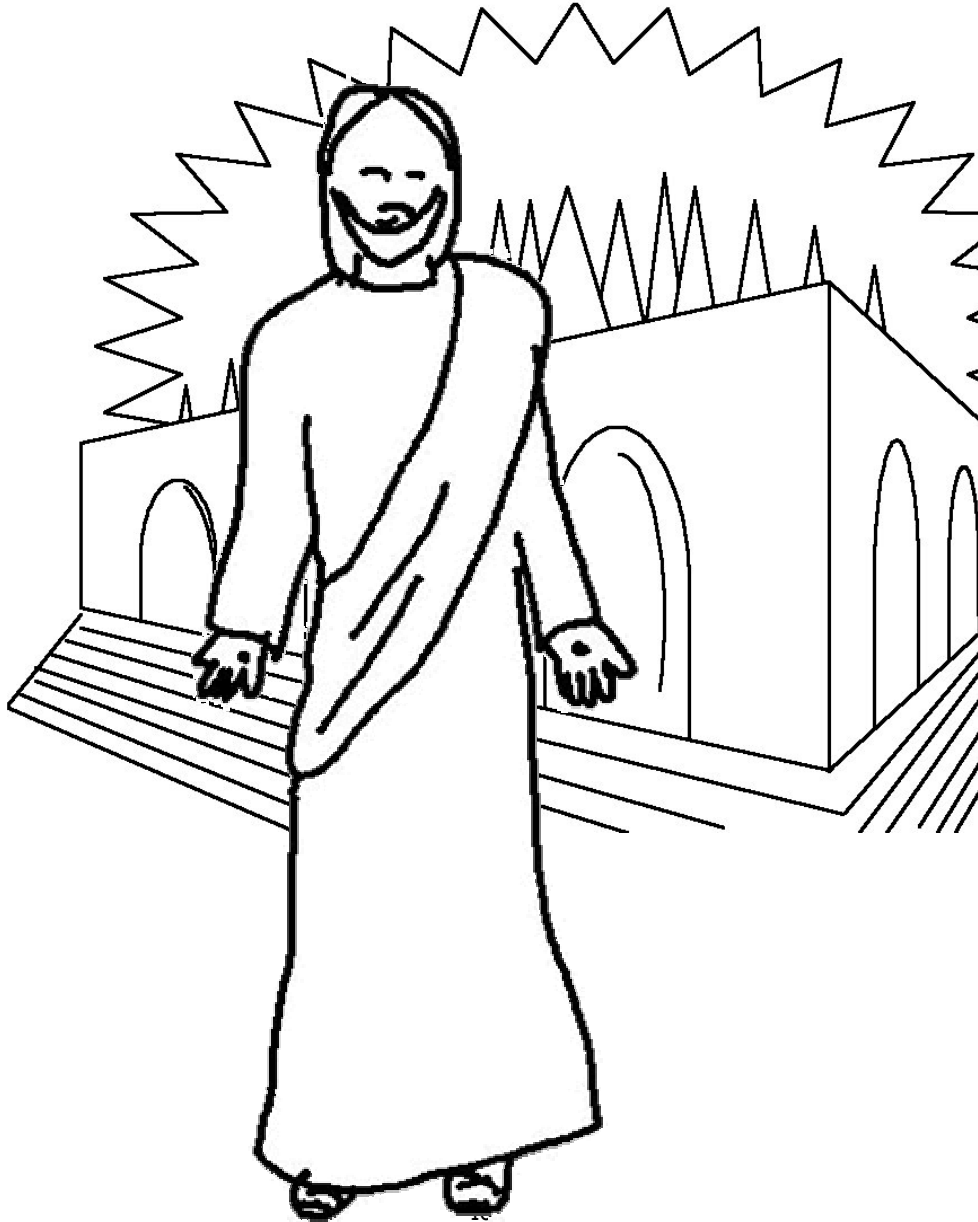

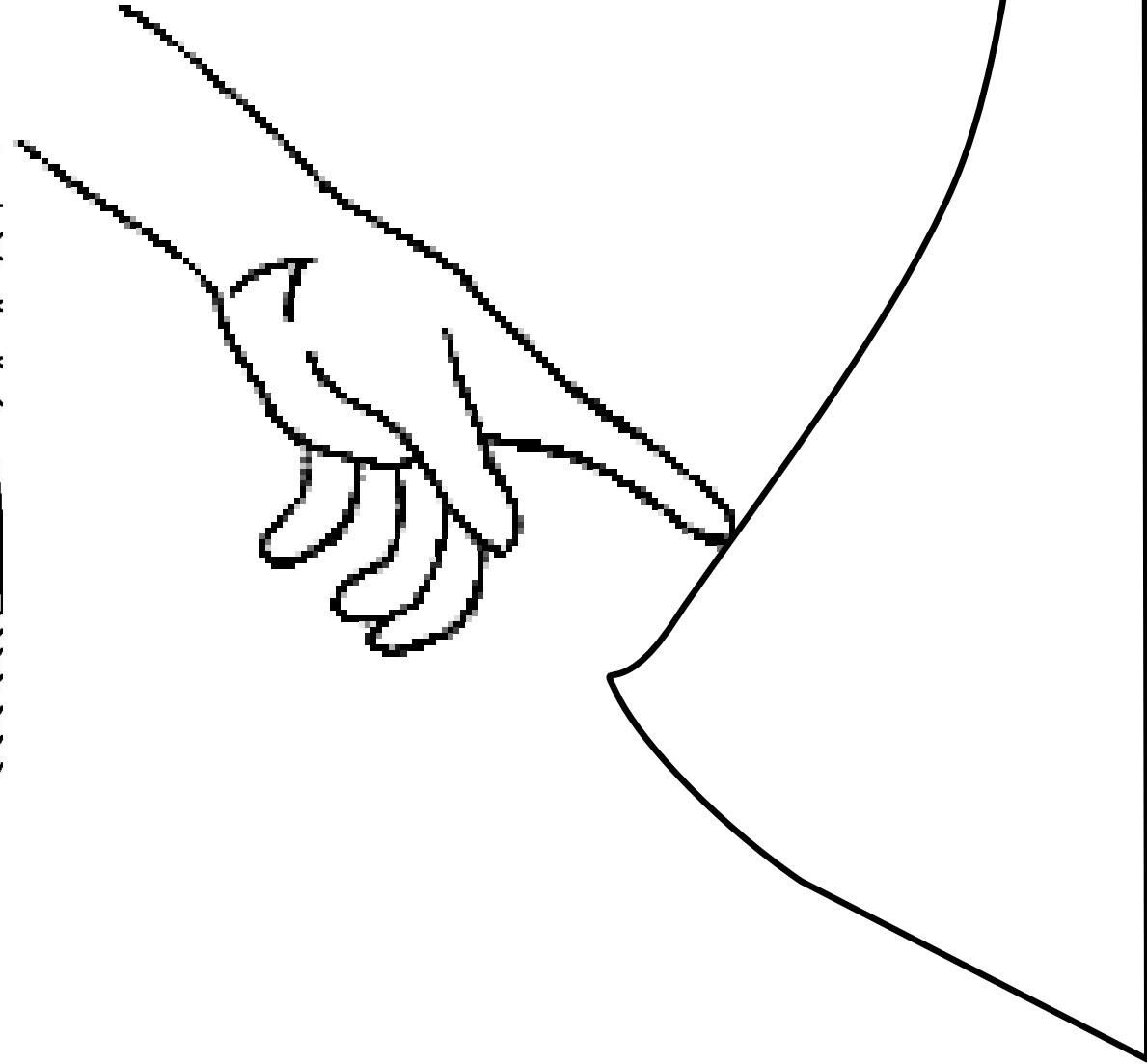

The sick woman believed that Jesus came from God, and could heal her.

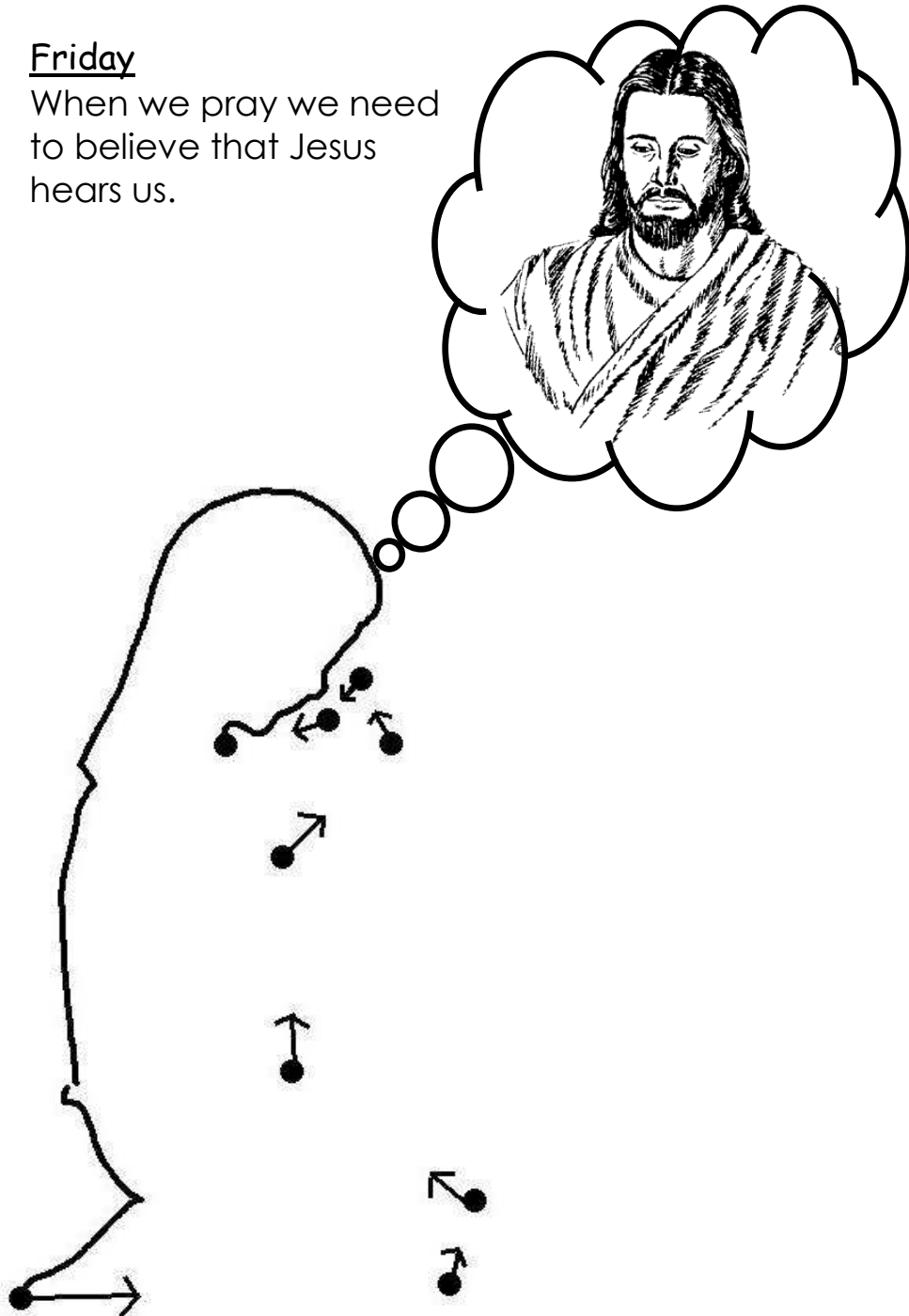

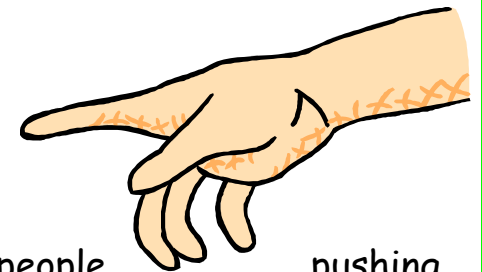

Sabbath
