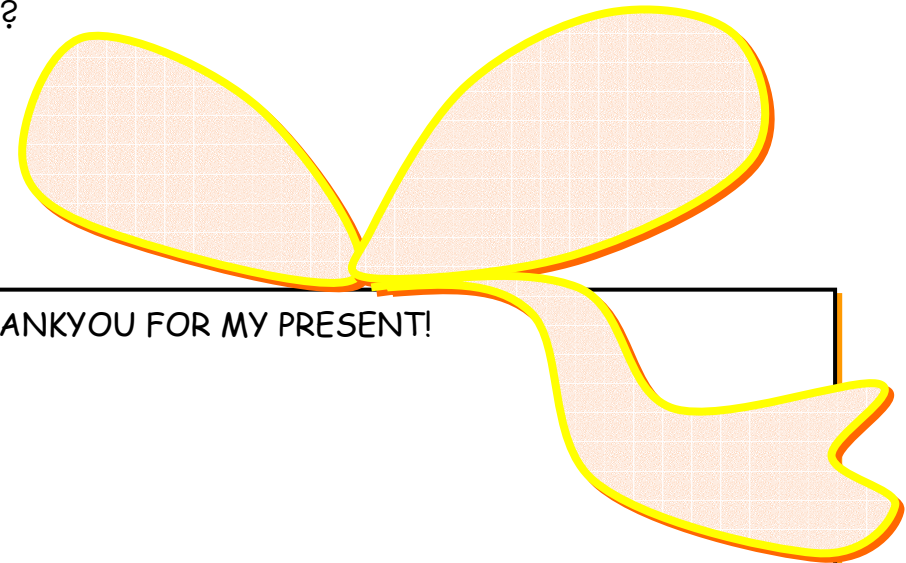

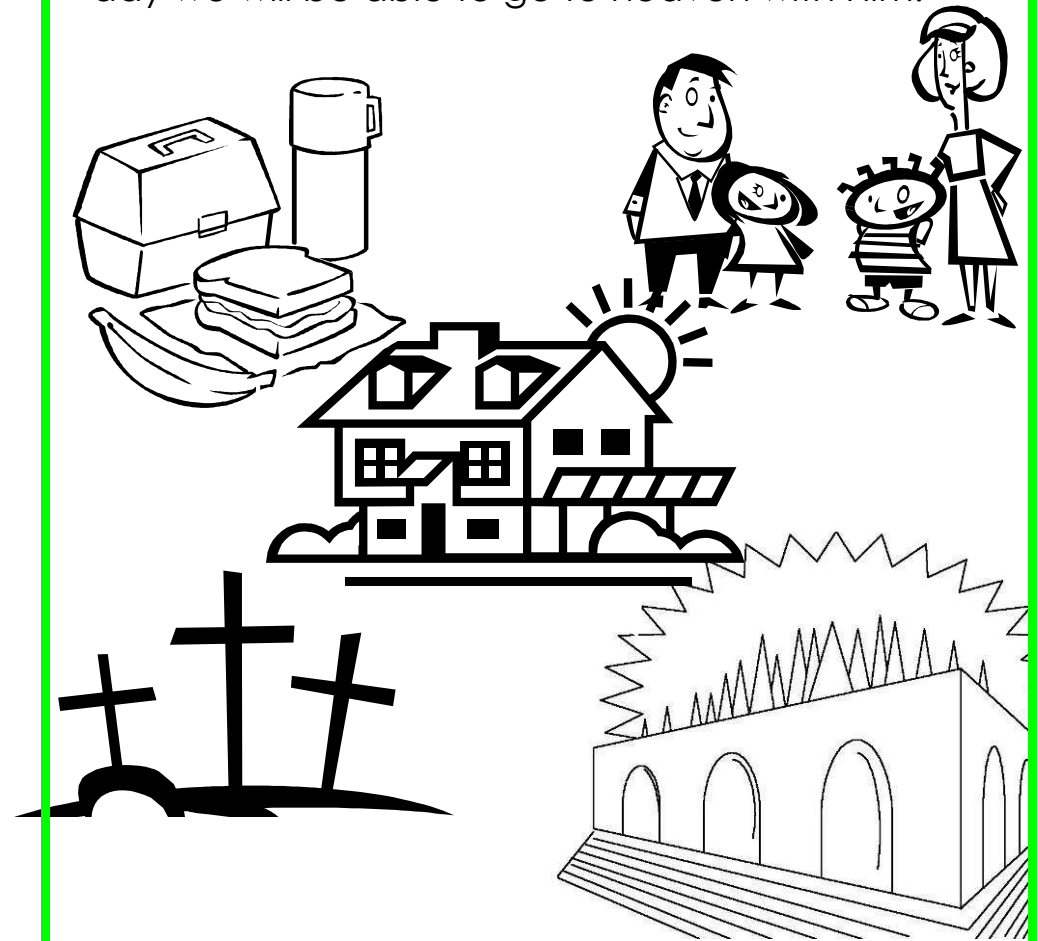
Thankyou Jesus

As Jesus was entering a town between Samaria and Galilee, ten men stood off in the distance called out in a very loud voice, "Jesus, please make us well again."



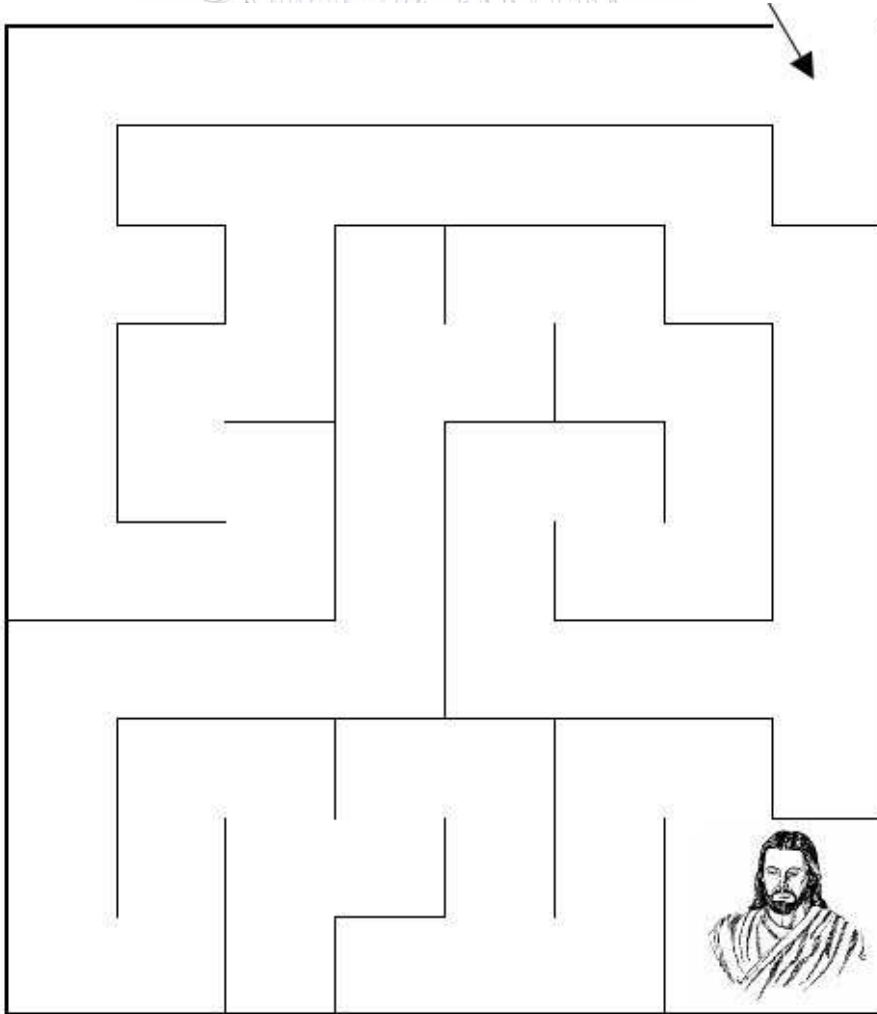
Now people with leprosy were not allowed to go near other people who were well; but if they thought they were better, they had to go and let the priest have a look at them, before they were allowed to go home.

Just as Jesus listened to the ten men who called out to Him, so He will listen to us and help us just like He helped them.

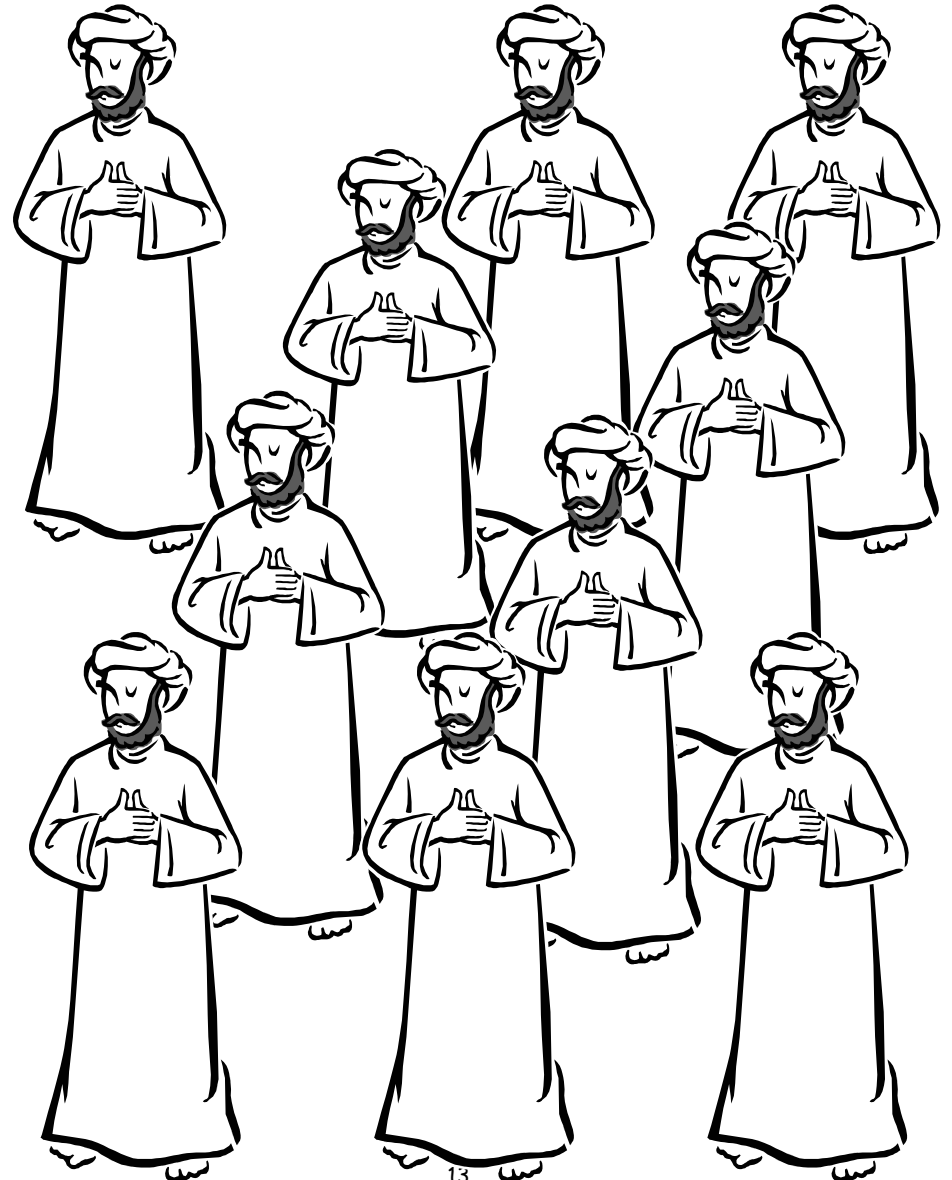
Monday

Tuesday

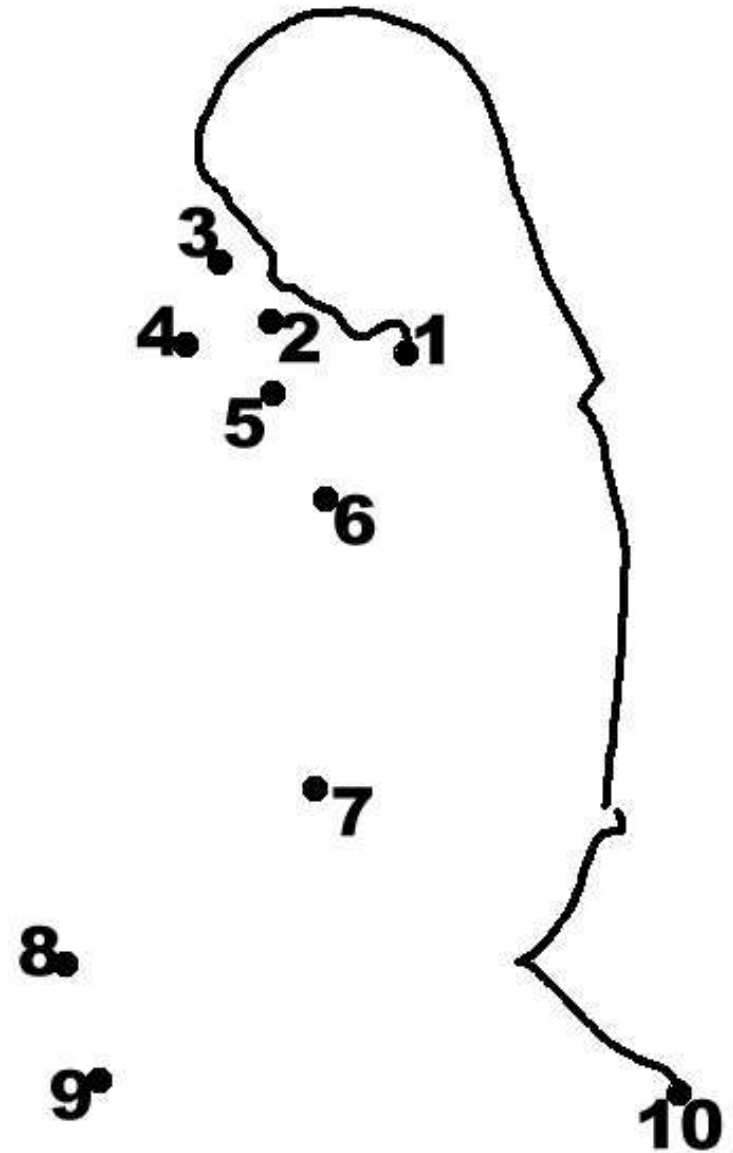
Jesus looked at the man and said,

Wednesday

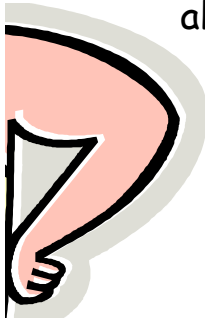
The men started off to see the priest but they hadn't gone very far down the road when one man noticed a change.

Jesus is always ready to listen to us and He will heal us and keep us safe throughout the day and the night when we ask Him.



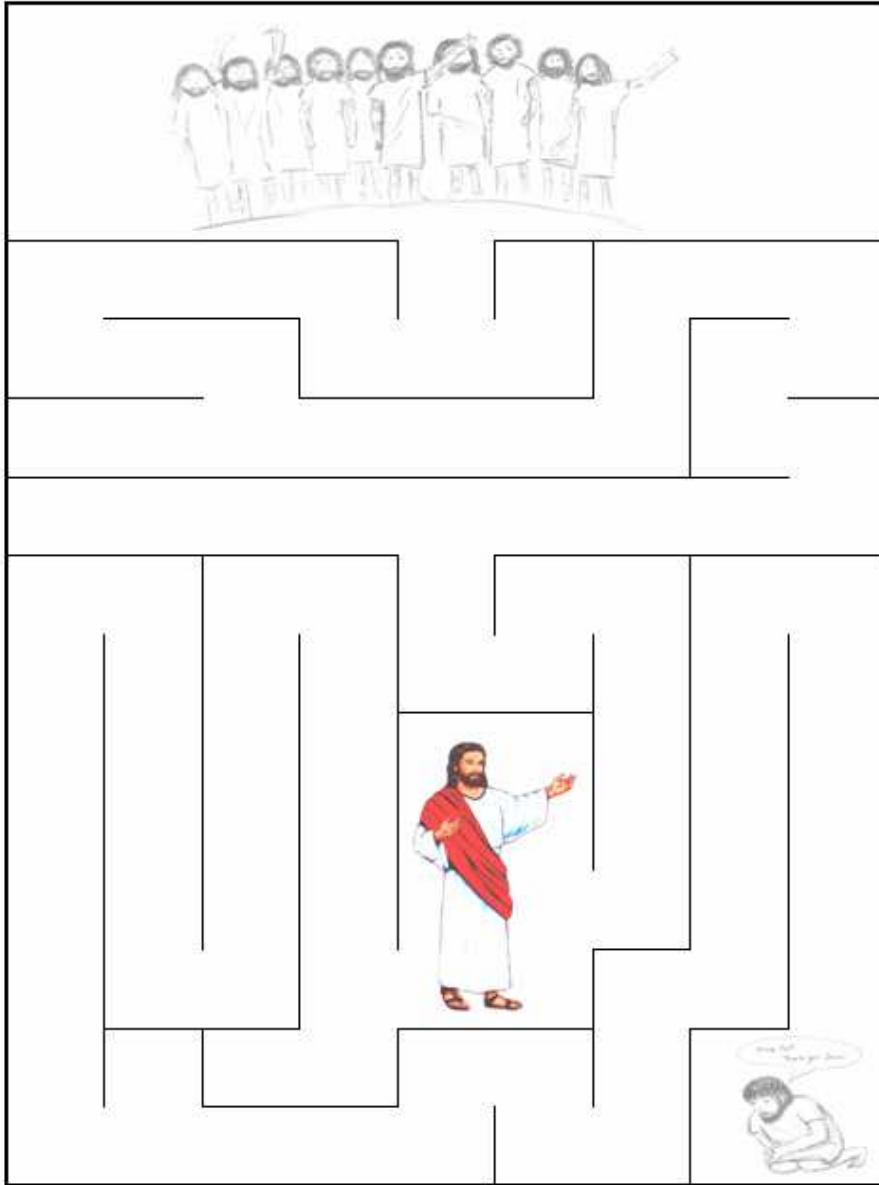
Monday

Have you said thank you to Jesus?



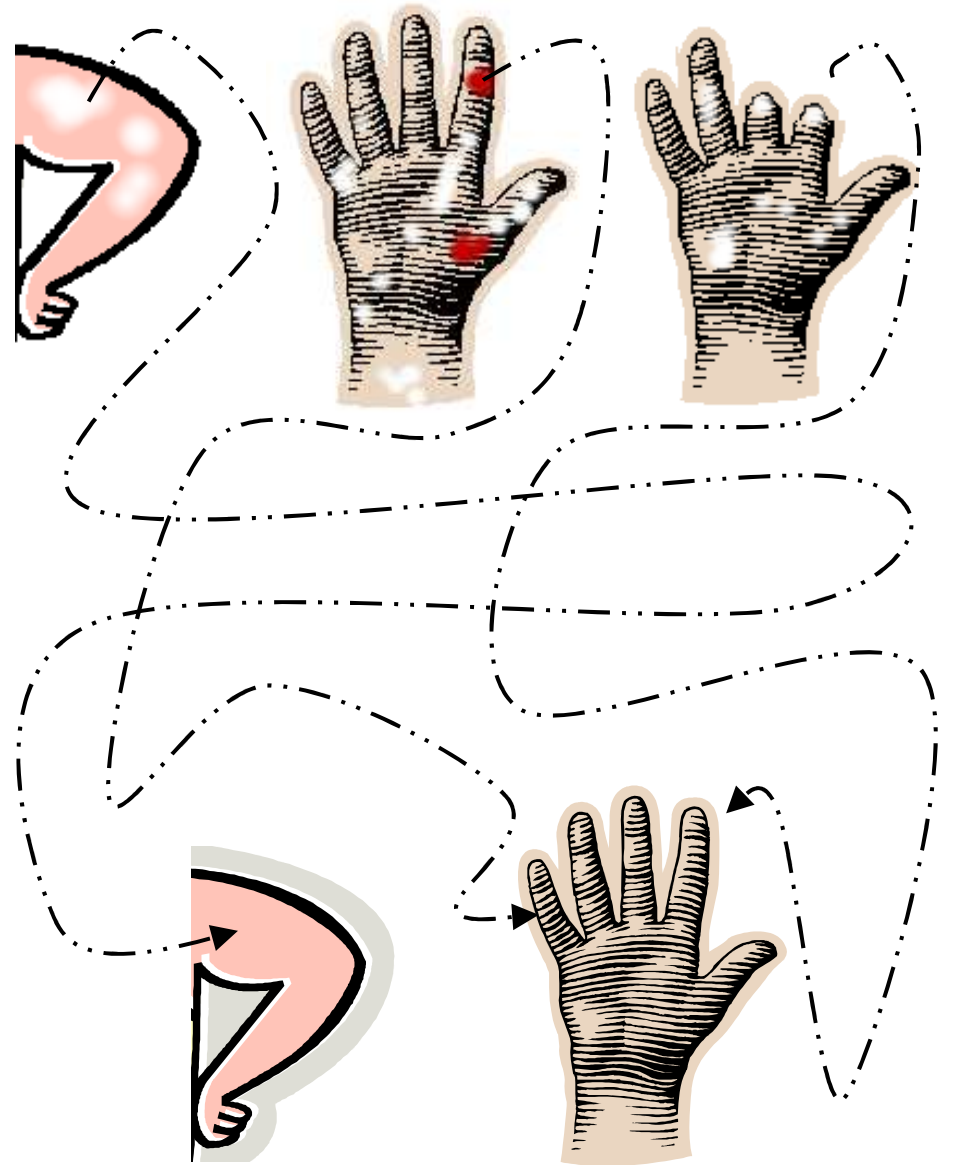
Sunday
