




<u>Friday</u>

Each Sabbath when we come to church we need to remember that this is God's special house and that He wants us to be reverent.


Reverent is a very big word but it means we need to walk not run, to sit up nicely and to be quiet. When we talk, to whisper and not use big voices when we are inside the church.

Here is something you can do in church to show Jesus you are happy.




<u>Sunday</u>


Jesus was not at all pleased. His face had a very stern look on it as He said, "My house, shall be called a house of prayer! But you have made it a den of thieves!"




What did Jesus say should be in His house?

They had been reverent and quiet in the church just like we need to be reverent and quiet in church so we can hear Jesus talking to us.




