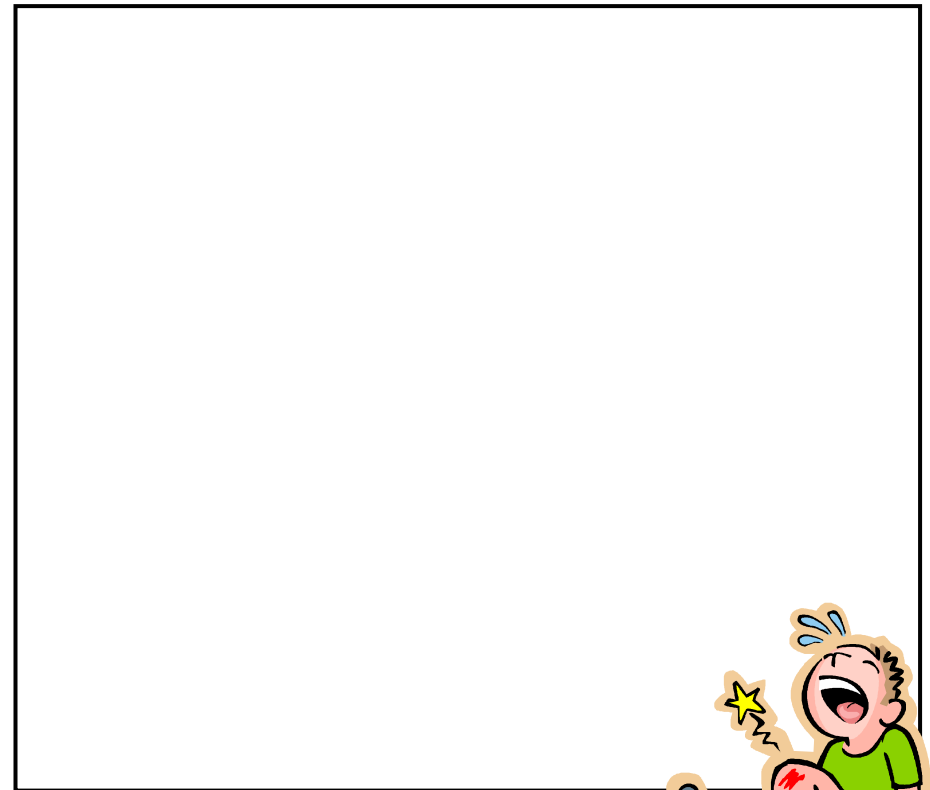

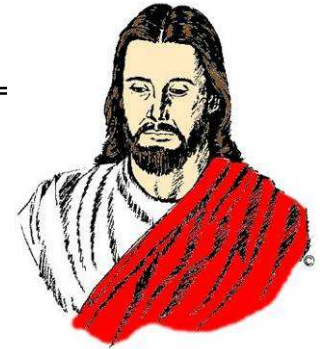

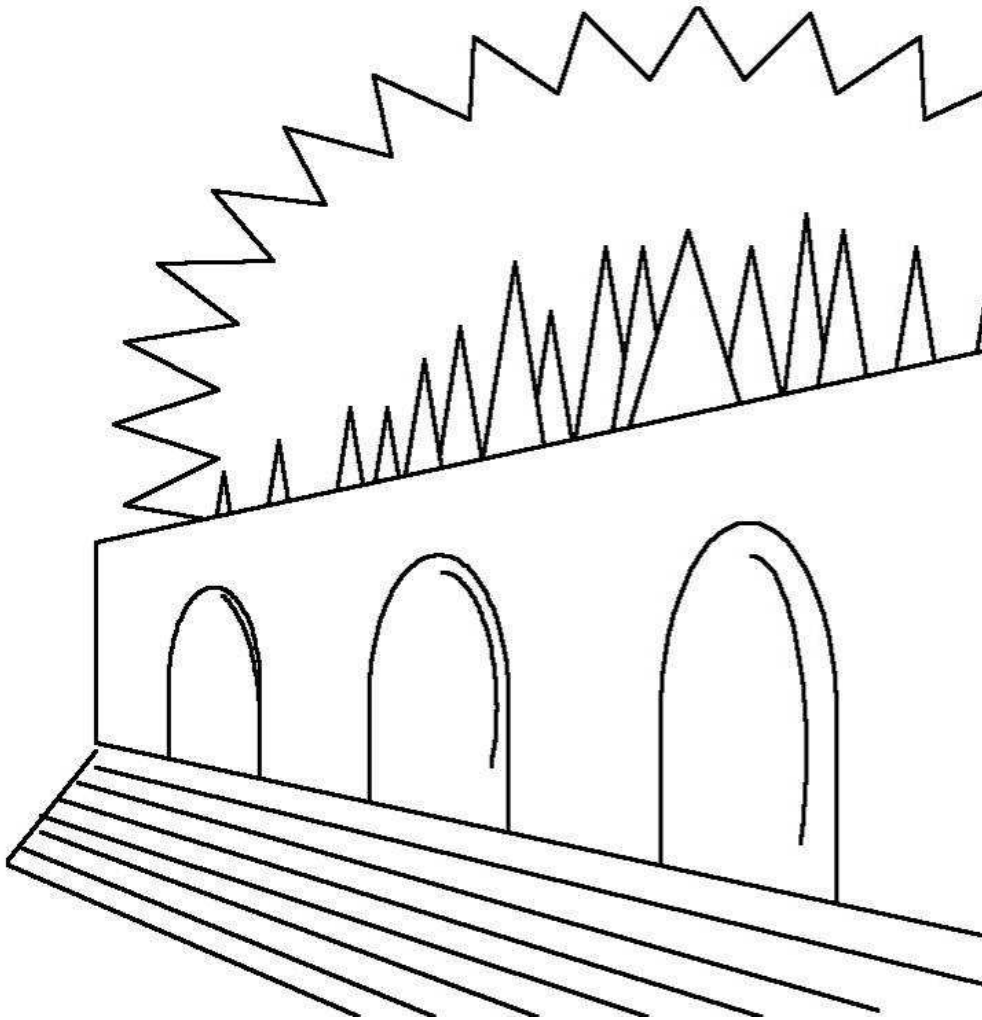
I am so glad that Jesus was willing to die for me and for you so that we can go heaven to live with Him when He comes.

They did many things to Him, things that hurt Him very much. They beat Him, teased Him and put a crown of thorns on His head. The thorns dug into His skin and made it bleed.

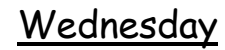
All the time while this was happening Jesus never complained or said or did anything, He knew that these terrible things had to happen to Him so He could save us from our sins and so that we could go

What would you do? What should you do?

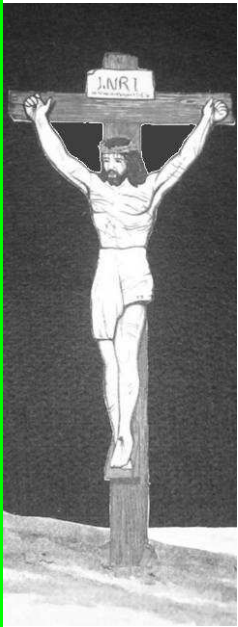


Wednesday

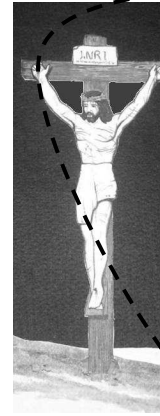

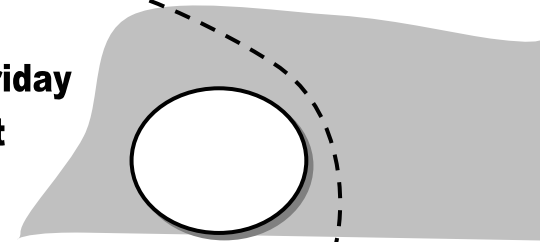
When people do things that hurt us we need to forgive them and ask God to forgive them just like Jesus did when the soldiers were hurting Him.

Sabbath

At the same time as Jesus was crucified, two thieves were also crucified. One of the thieves teased Jesus but the other one said, "We did wrong things and deserve to die but Jesus didn't." Then He asked Jesus to forgive him his sins. Jesus told him that his sins were forgiven and that one day after Jesus comes again, he would be in heaven with Jesus.
