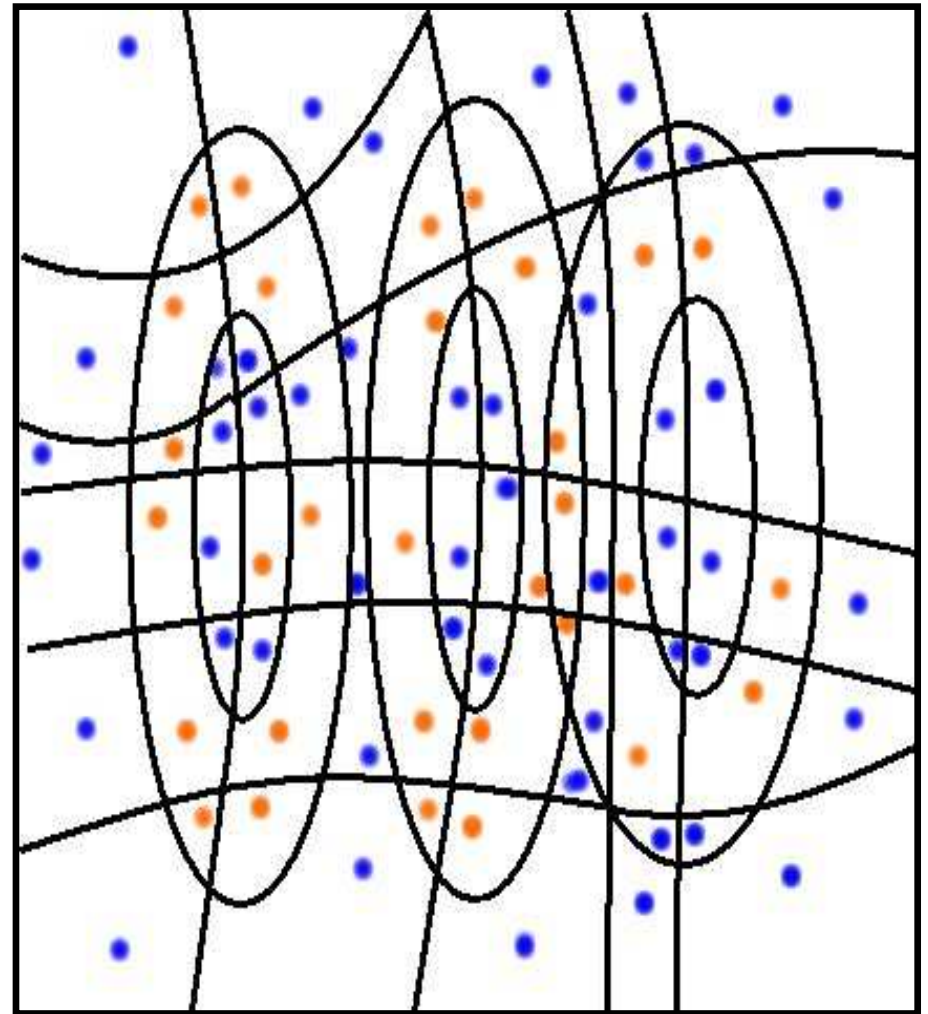

Do you know who made our world?



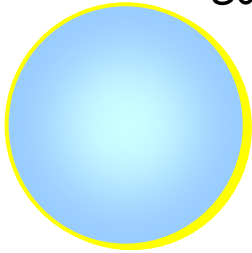
Sunday

On the second day Jesus said "Let there be space between the waters." And there was space, and Jesus called the space the sky.

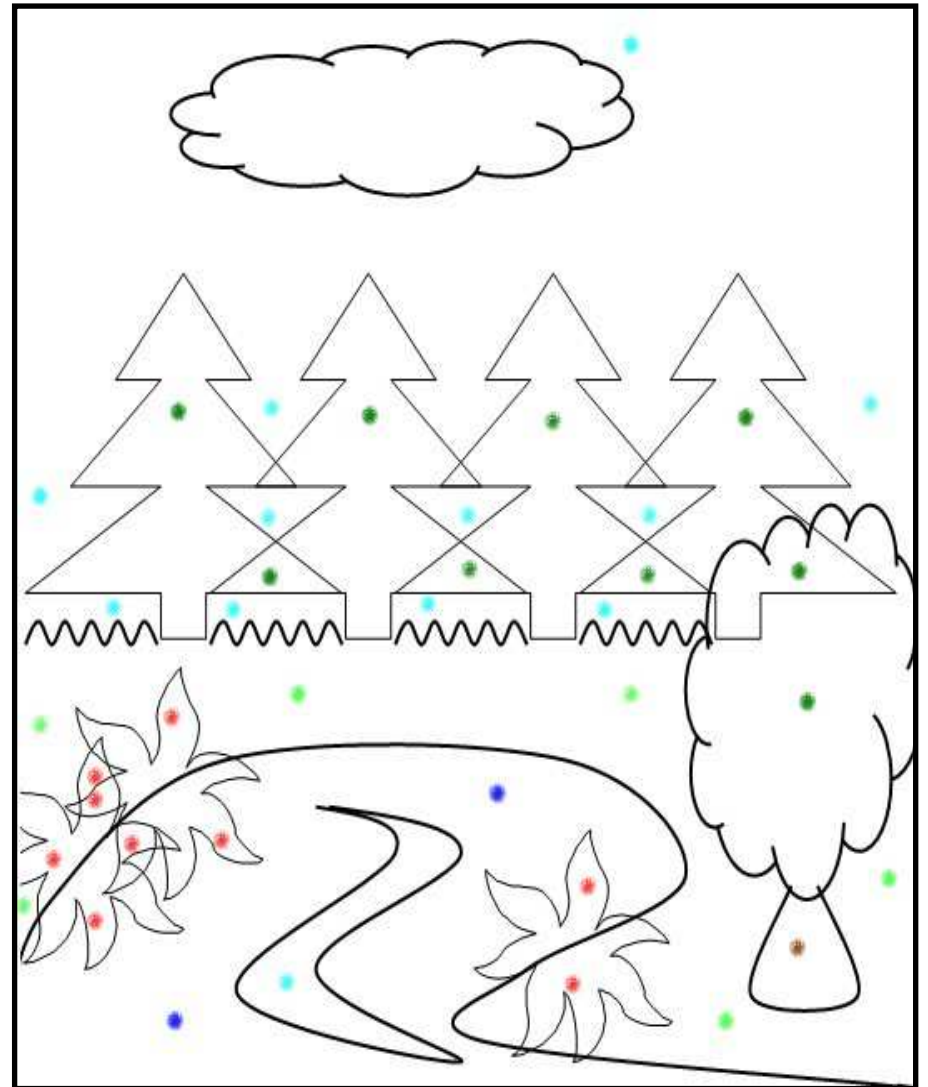
In that space is the air that we need to breathe to stay alive, the wind that we feel on our skin, and the clouds we see in the sky.

Then it was night time and morning and that was the second day.



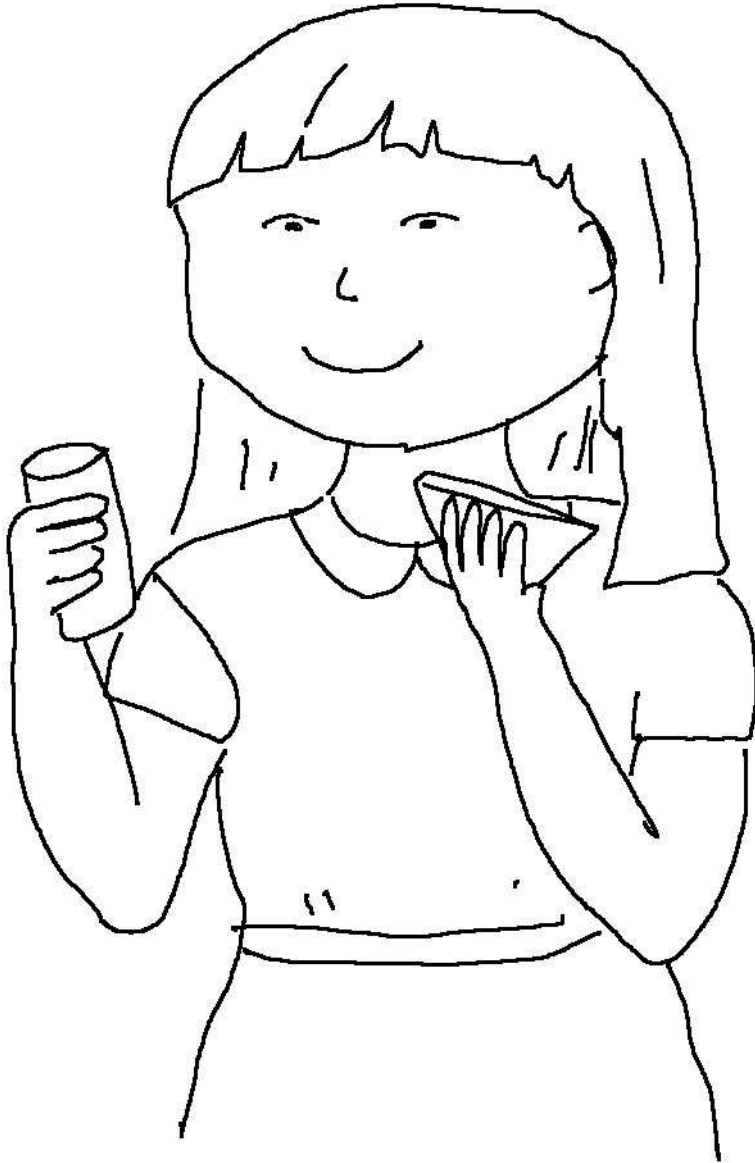
Friday

Use the coloured dots to help you colour in the picture to see some of the wonderful things that God made for us.



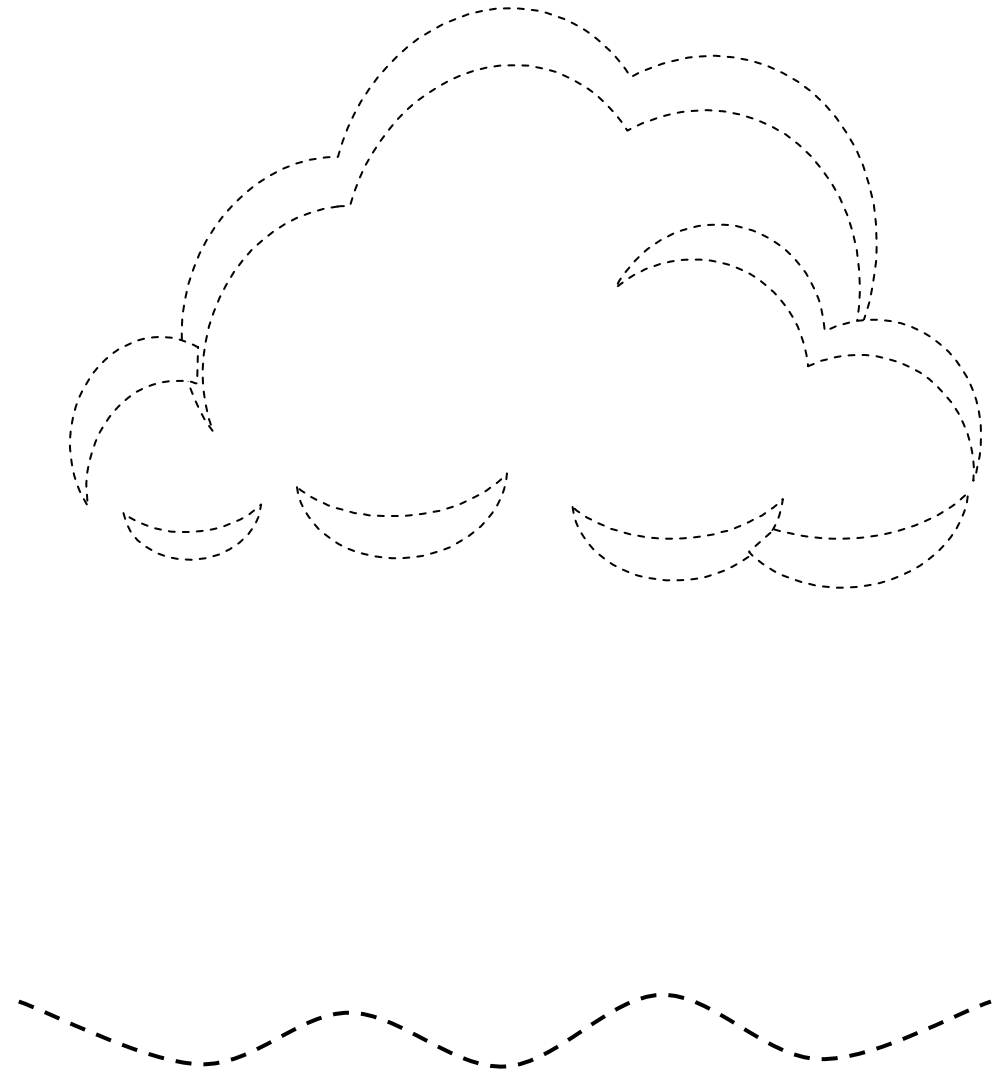
Thursday

God knows just what we need to live. He gives us air to breath and water to drink.



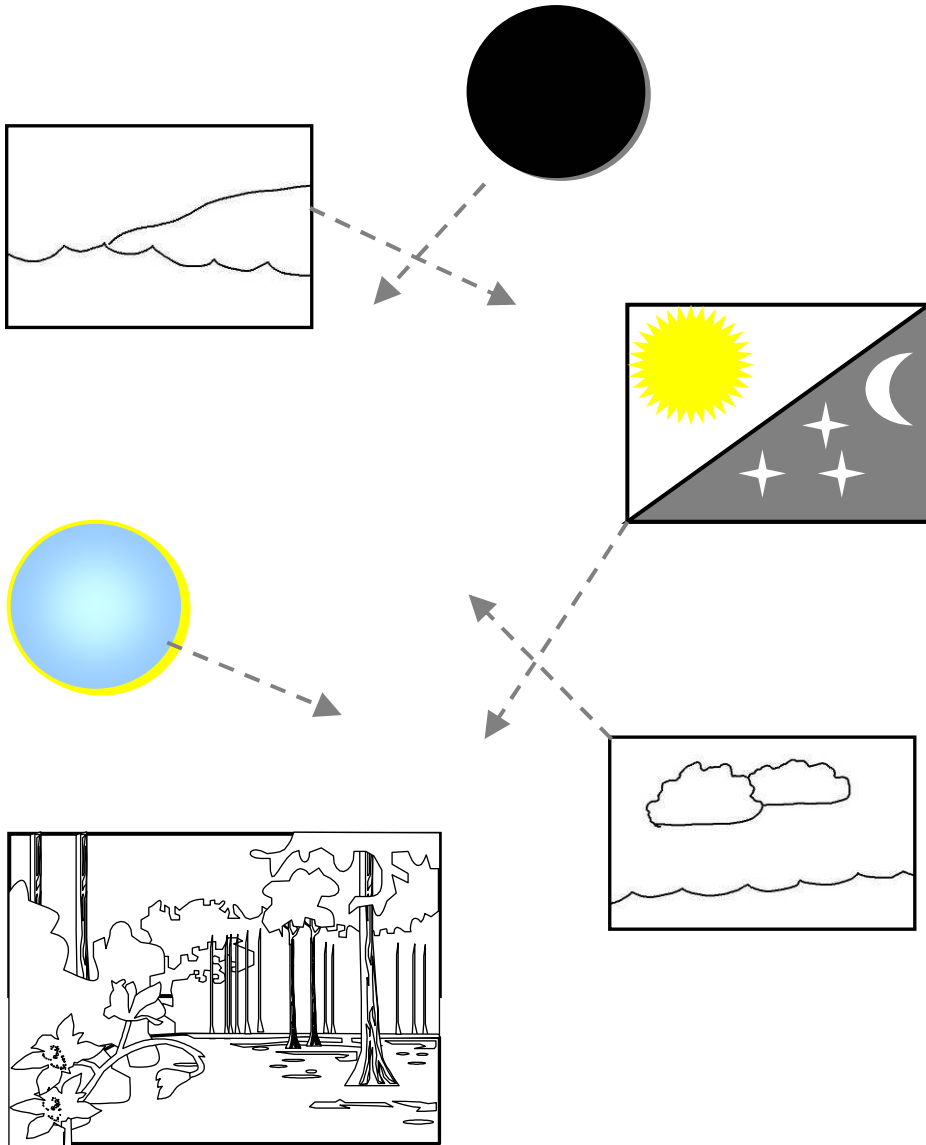
Monday

God knew that people, animals and plants could not live without air, so He created the air first.



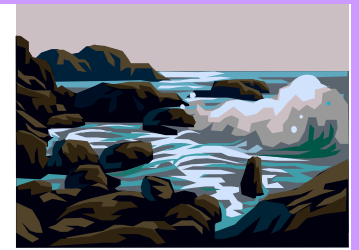
Tuesday

Extend the arrows to join the things that God created in the correct order. The answer is on the back page.

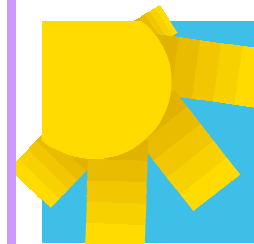


Wednesday
