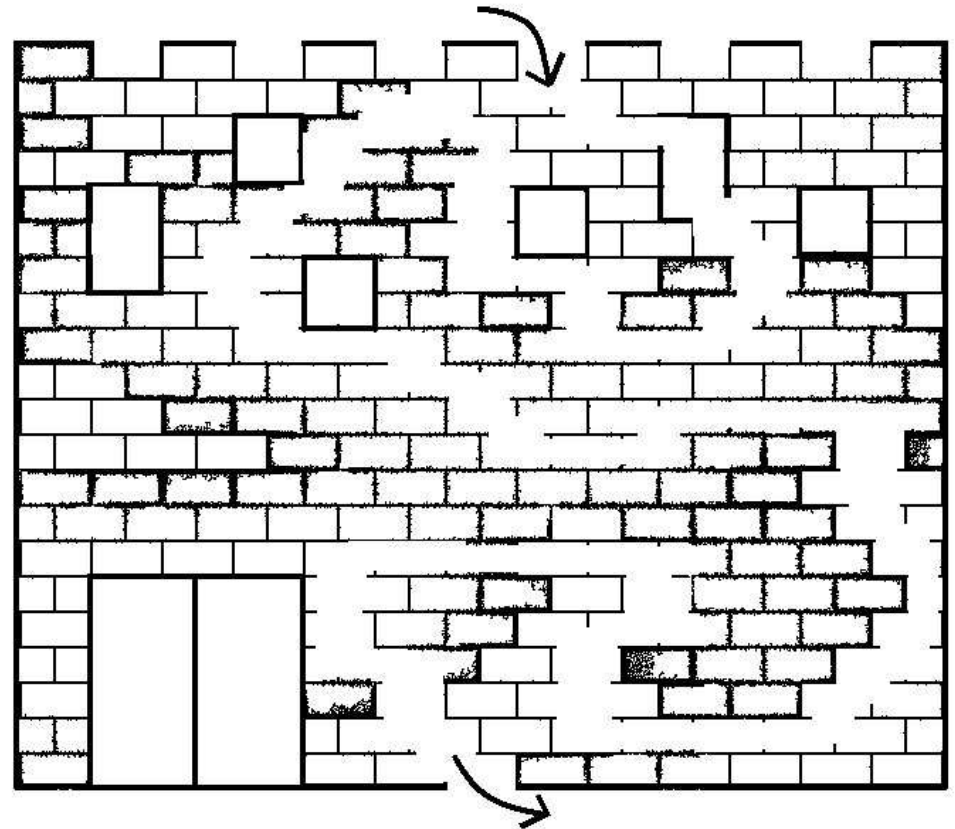

Do you do your best?



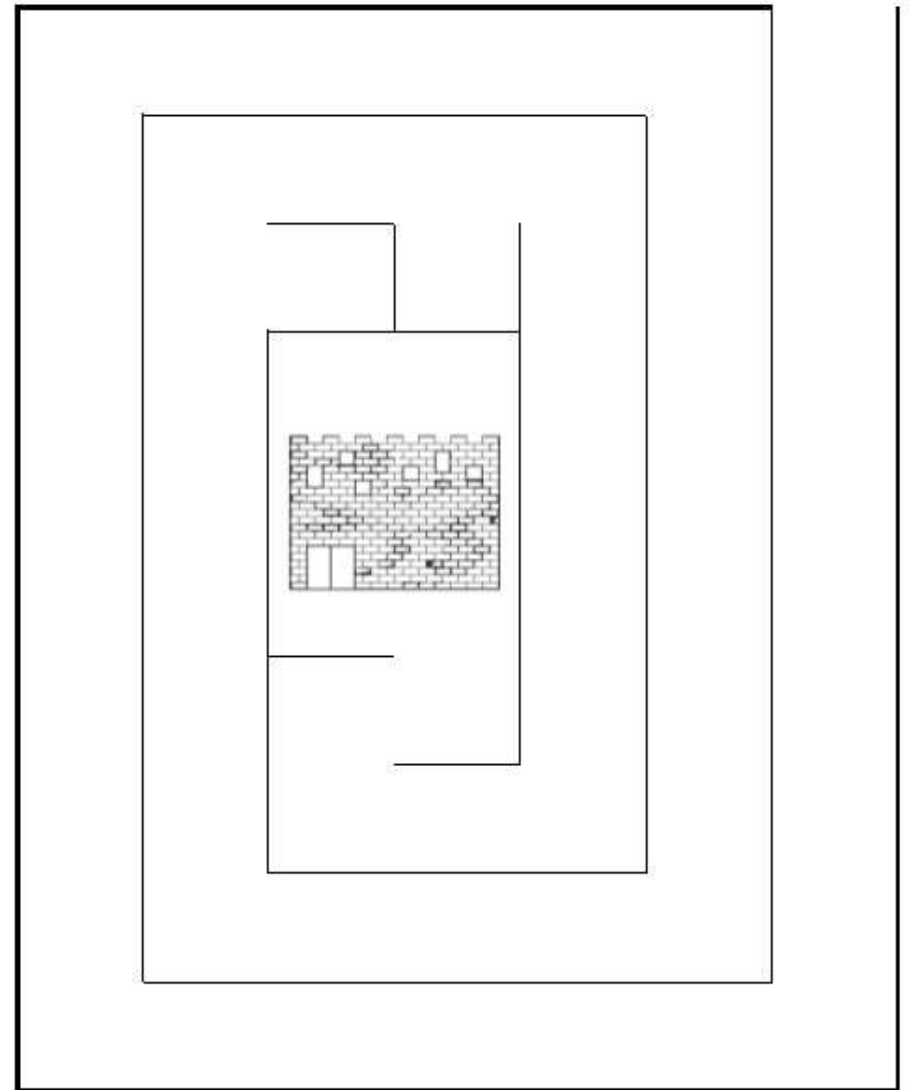
Thursday

Monday

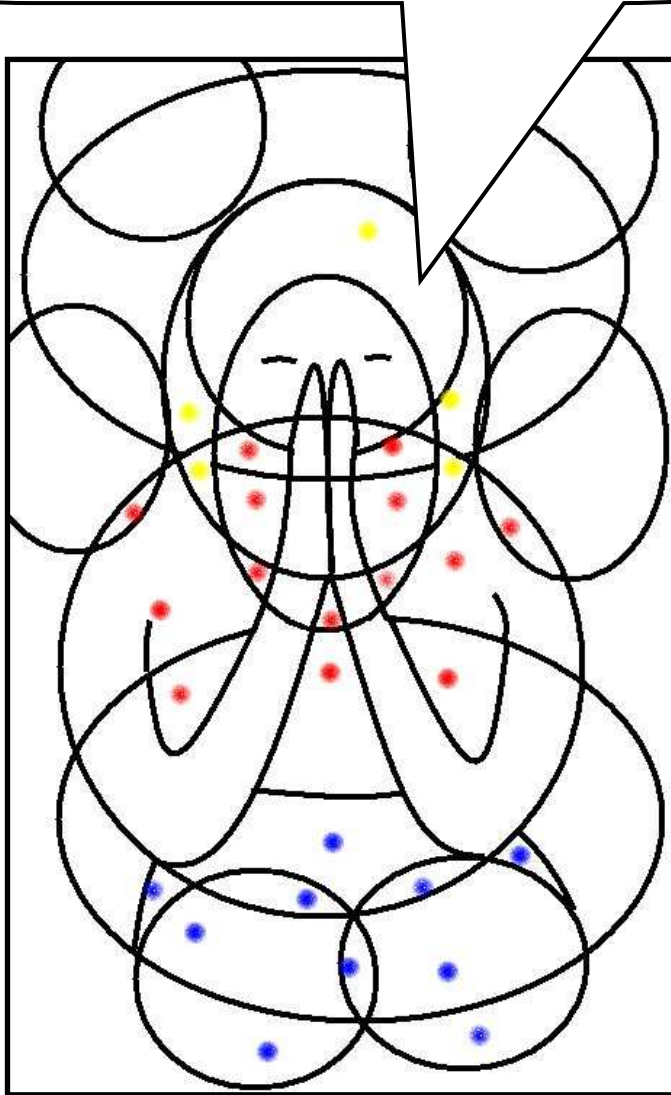
What did God tell the Israelites to do to conquer Jericho? Follow the maze around the city.
