





Jesus was very pleased with what He had made. He told the fish and birds to have lots of babies that are just like themselves.

Use a ruler to extend each arrow to show what God created on each day.






<u>Thursday</u>

God did something special when He created people. Instead of just speaking, God made Adam from the dirt.




Monday
