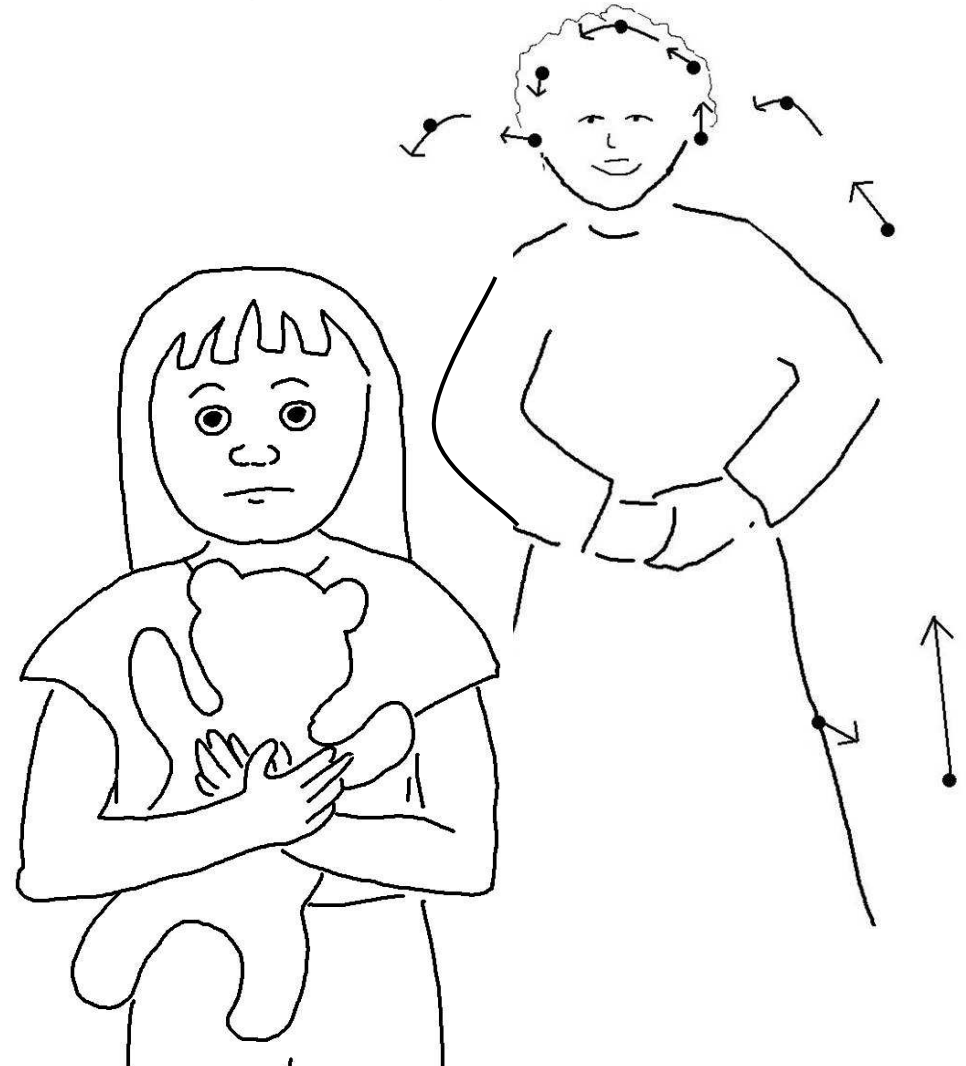

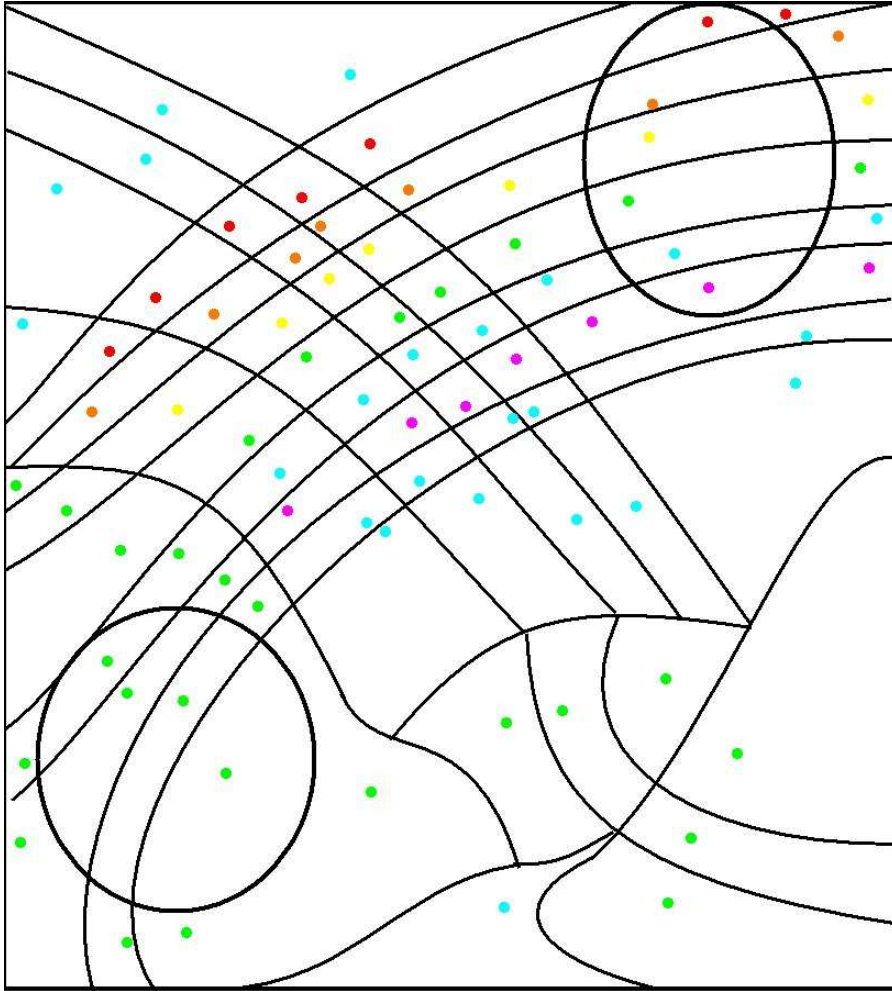
### Friday

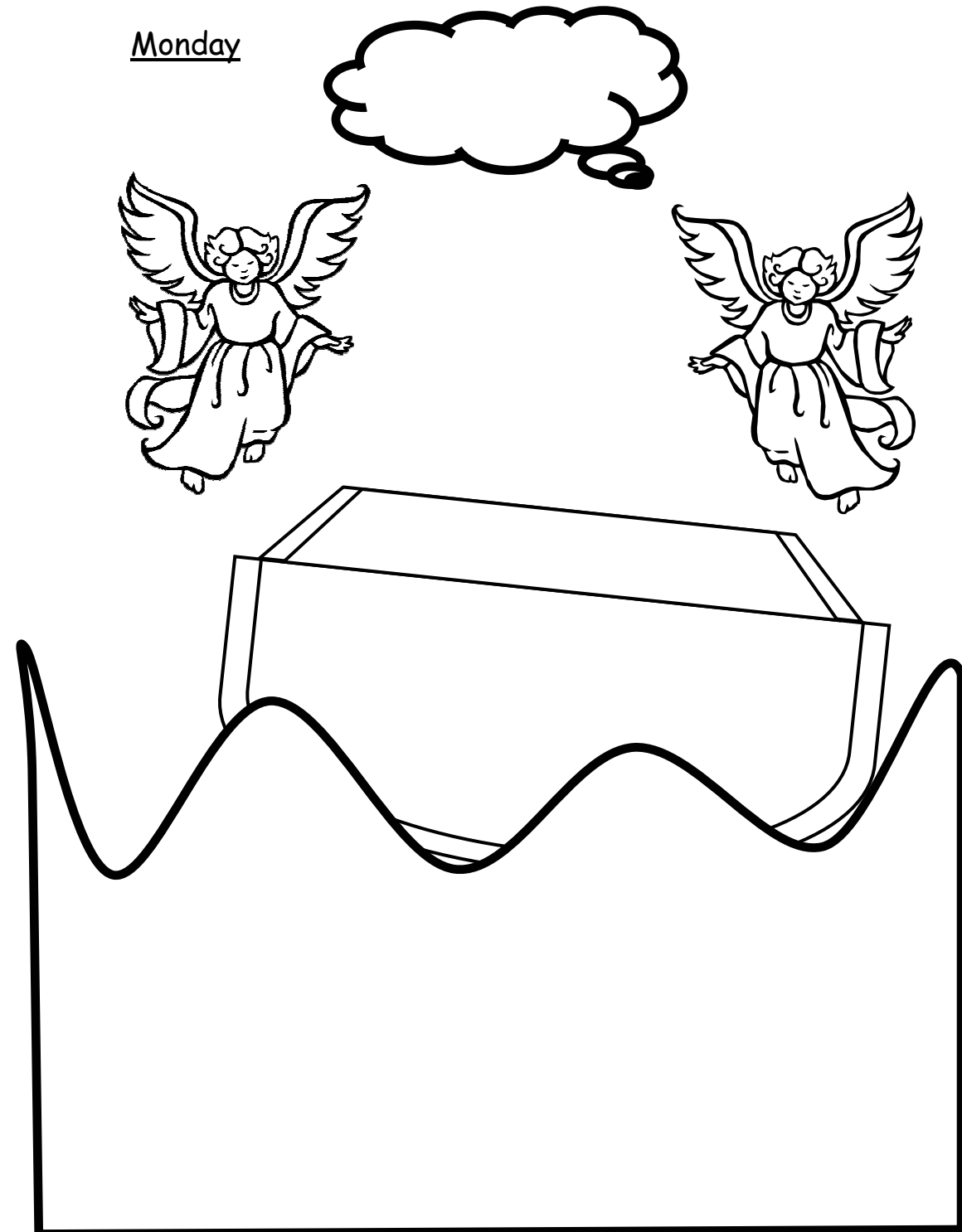


Thursday

God gave a sign of his promise to Noah.

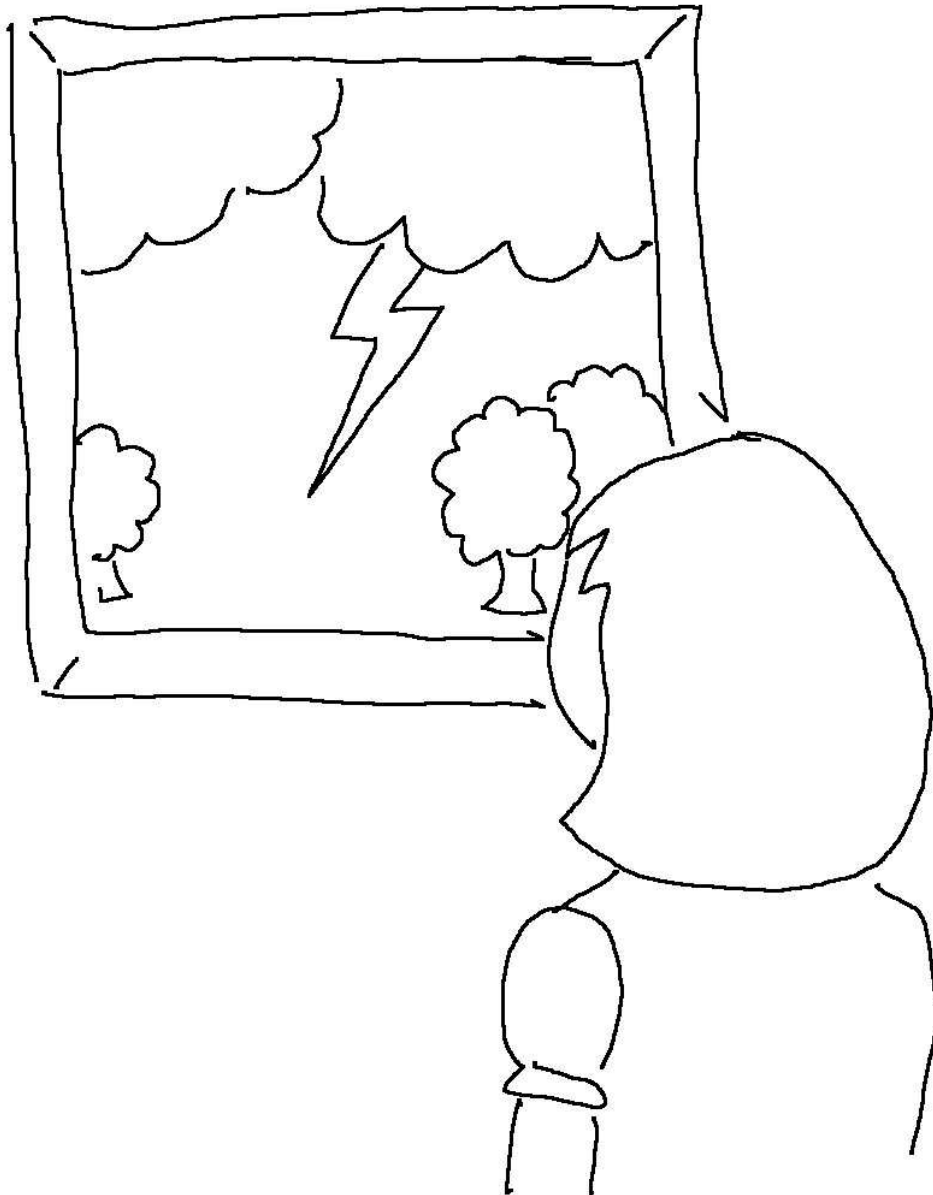

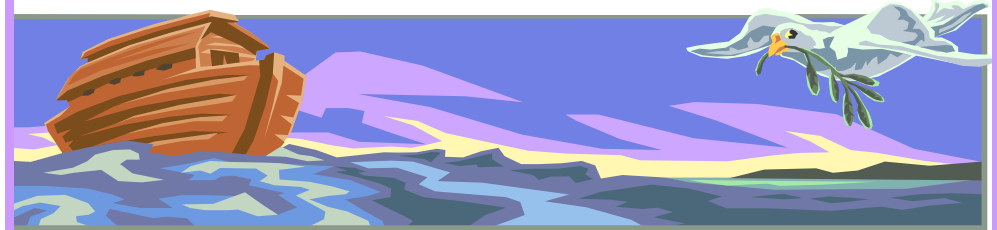
## Tuesday
