<u>Sunday</u>



When Jonah didn't want to do what God told him to, he ran away! But he couldn't really run away from God.





Johnny has been playing with the blocks.

But Johnny can't hide from Mummy.


Johnny says Mummy and prays and asks God Then he picks up his blocks.






<u>Thursday</u>
