The Giant Statue




God looked after Daniel's friends; they didn't even smell of smoke! God will send His angel to look after you too.

Who helped Daniel's friends to be brave enough to stand up when everyone bowed down?


Who will help you to do the right thing?

Daniel's friends, Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego, didn't bow down when everyone else did.


Draw the 3 men standing up.



Tuesday


Who were Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego obeying?
