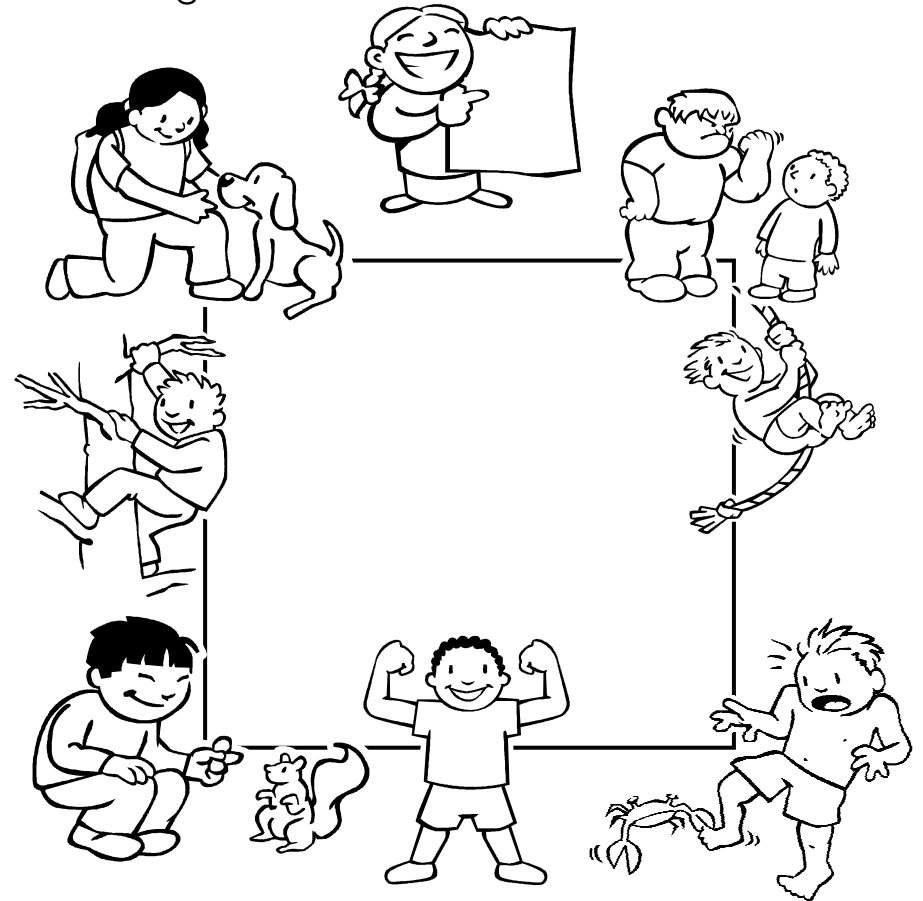

David walked down the hill, he crossed the river and stopped to pick up five small stones and put them in his shepherd's bag. Then he walked up the hill towards Goliath.

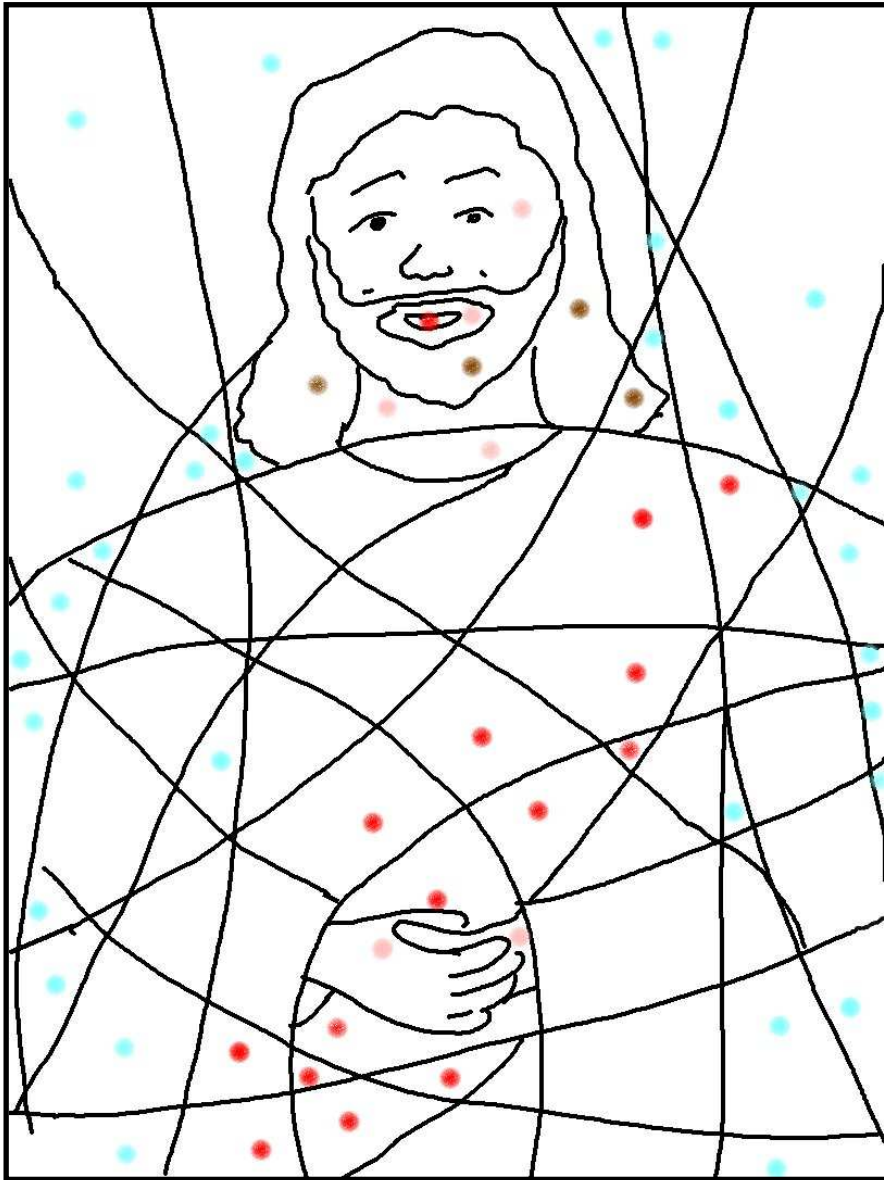
Friday

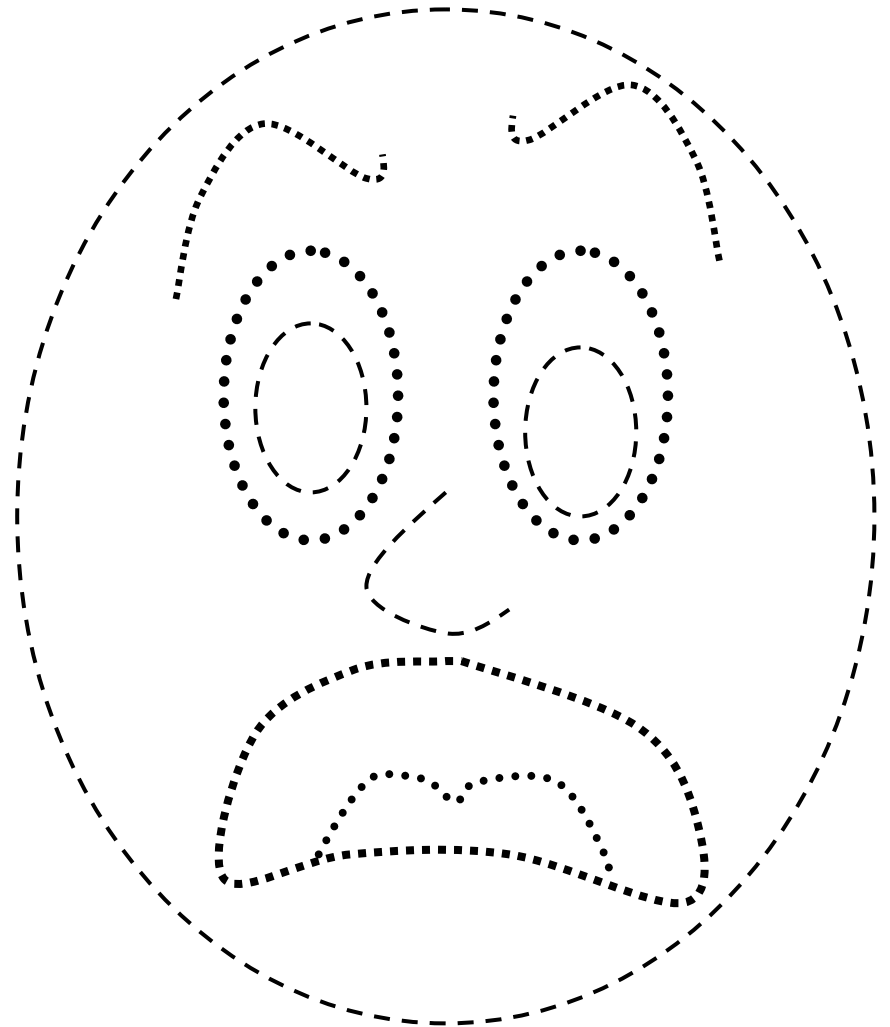
Thursday

Who was helping David?



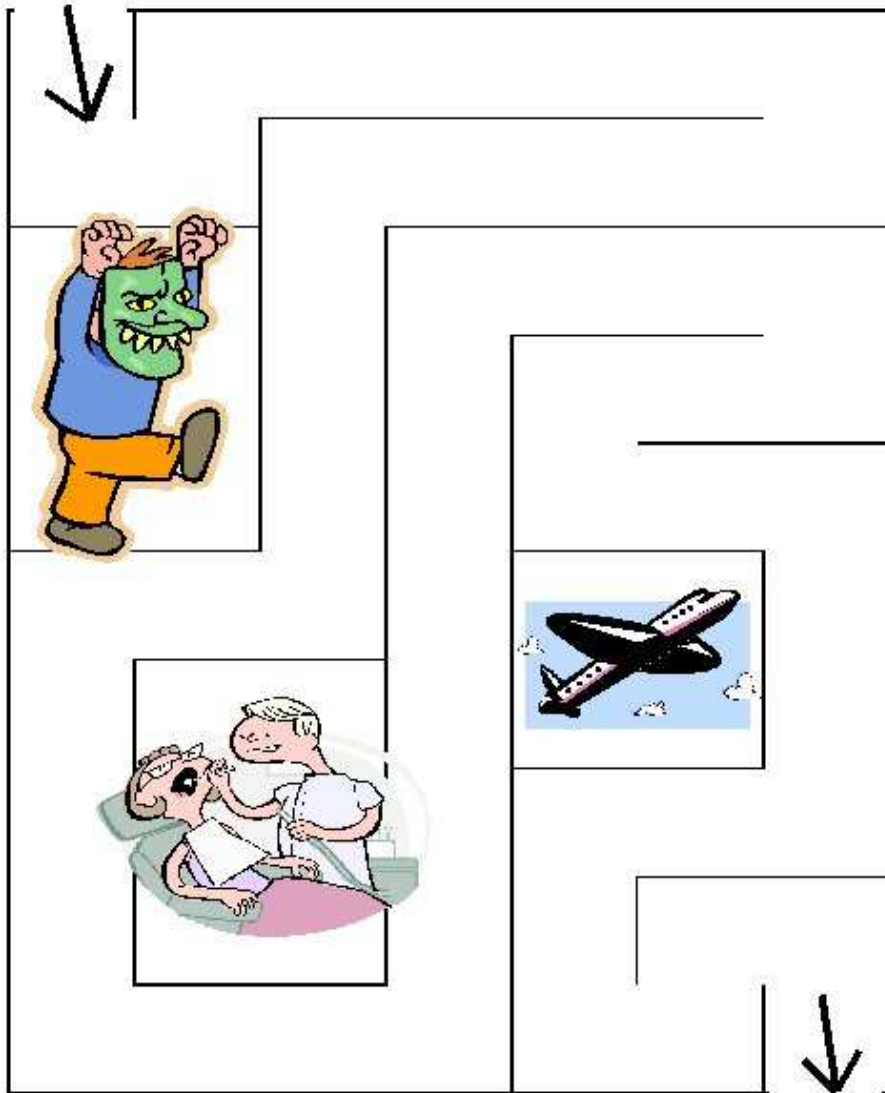
Monday
