Sabbath

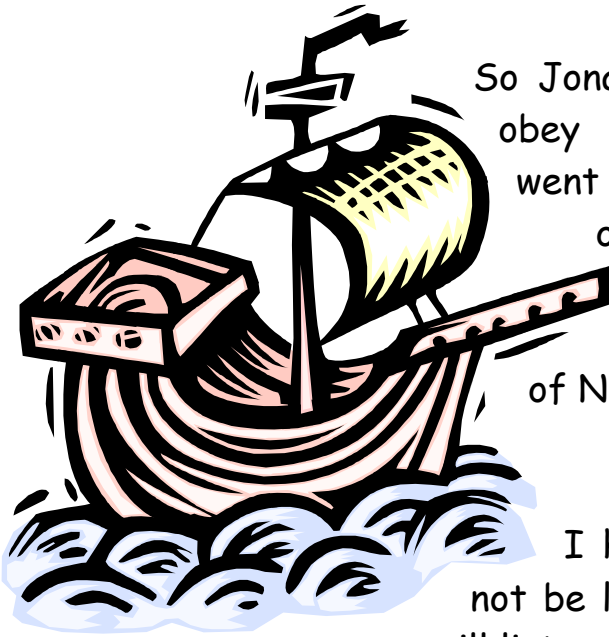
Who do you think is being obedient?

I hope that you will not be like Jonah; I hope you will listen and obey when you are asked to do something.

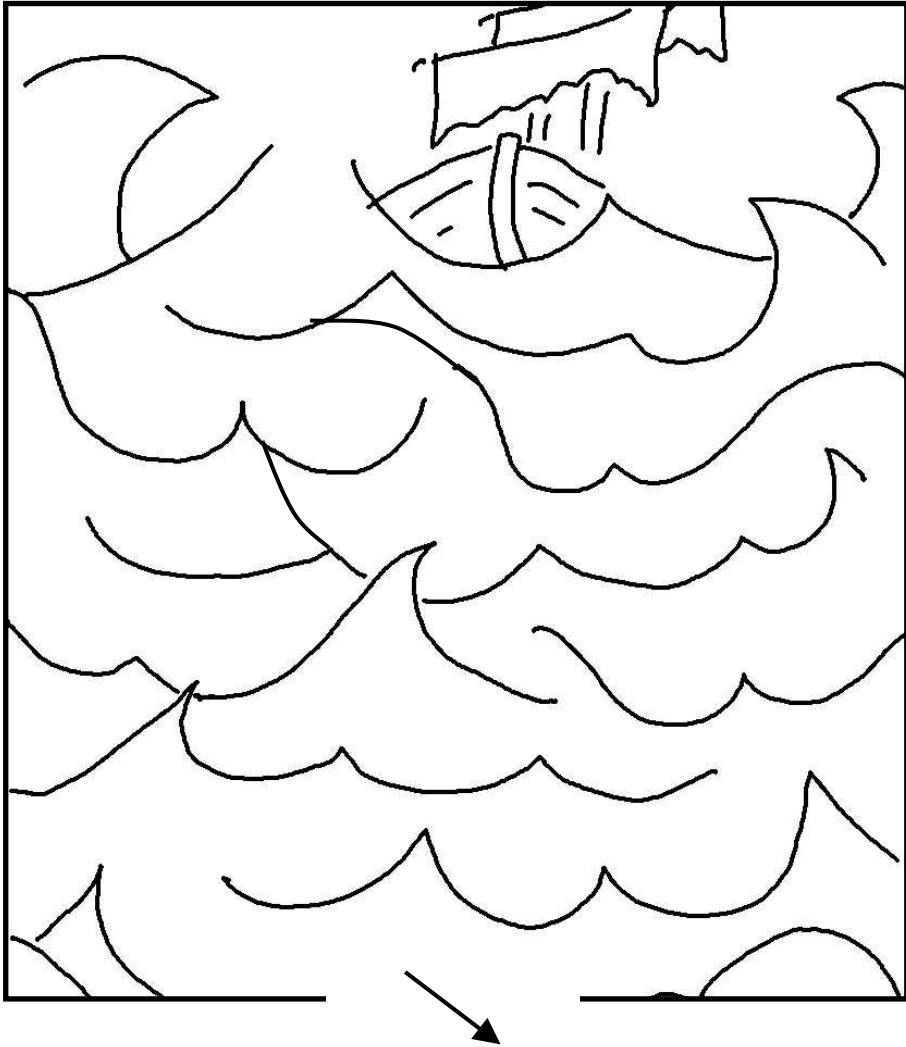
Friday

Jonah couldn't hide from God and neither can you. He knows where you are all the time.



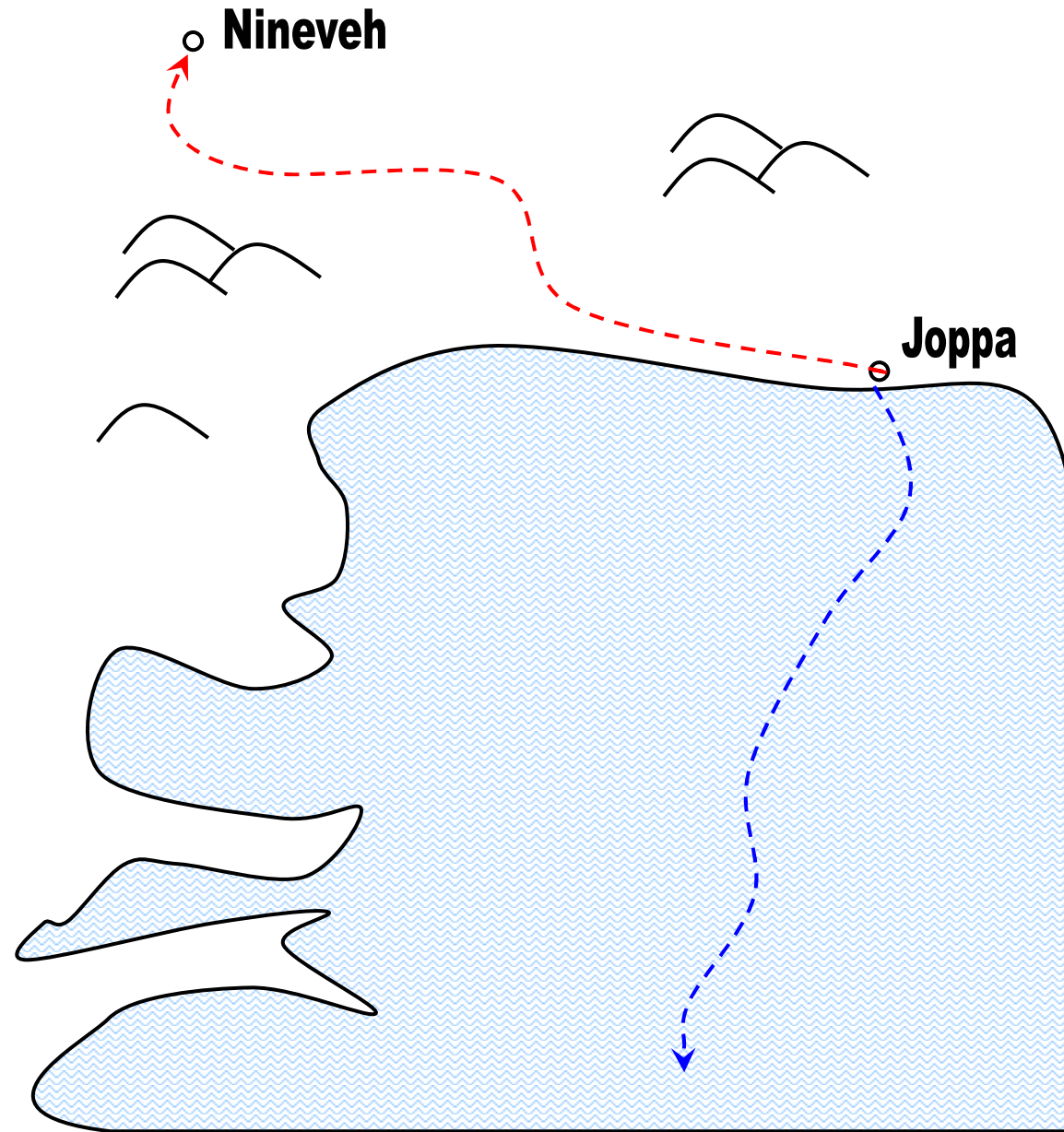
Thursday

Tuesday

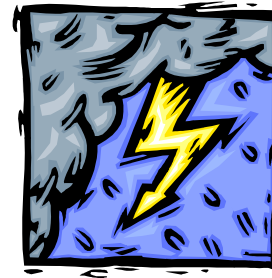
Do you listen and obey when Mummy or Daddy tells you to do something? Put a tick next to the children who are listening and obeying.
