
Now it was nearly time for the sun to go down; the people had been listening to Jesus all day.



Friday


We can be like the people and spend time with Jesus when we listen to Bible stories, pray, sing songs about Jesus, and look at the trees, flowers, birds and animals that He made.


When everyone had had enough, there was still food left over.
