



Who is the most important person?









<u>Sunday</u>



Jesus has given you a special angel to look after you; and Jesus said that your angel sees God all the time.




<u>Thursday</u>

Jesus was happy to see the children; He said, "Let the children come to me. Don't stop them!"




<u>Monday</u>
