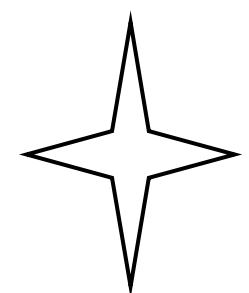

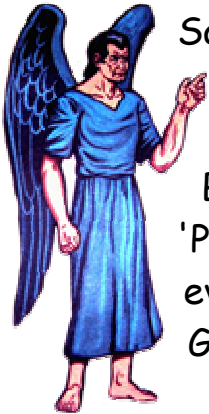

But Jesus told him, "No! The Bible says, 'People do not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God.'"



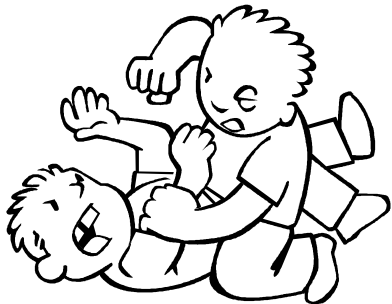
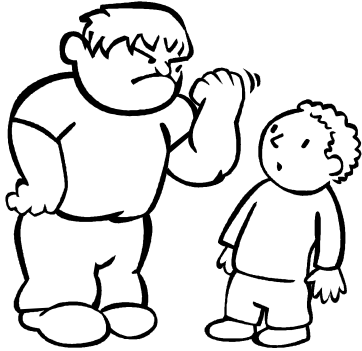
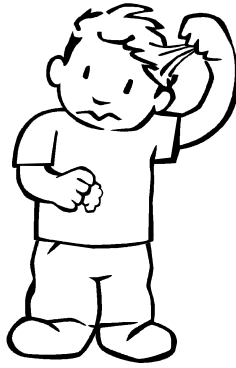
### Friday

Satan came when Jesus was very hungry. Satan told Jesus to turn some of the stones into bread so that He could eat.

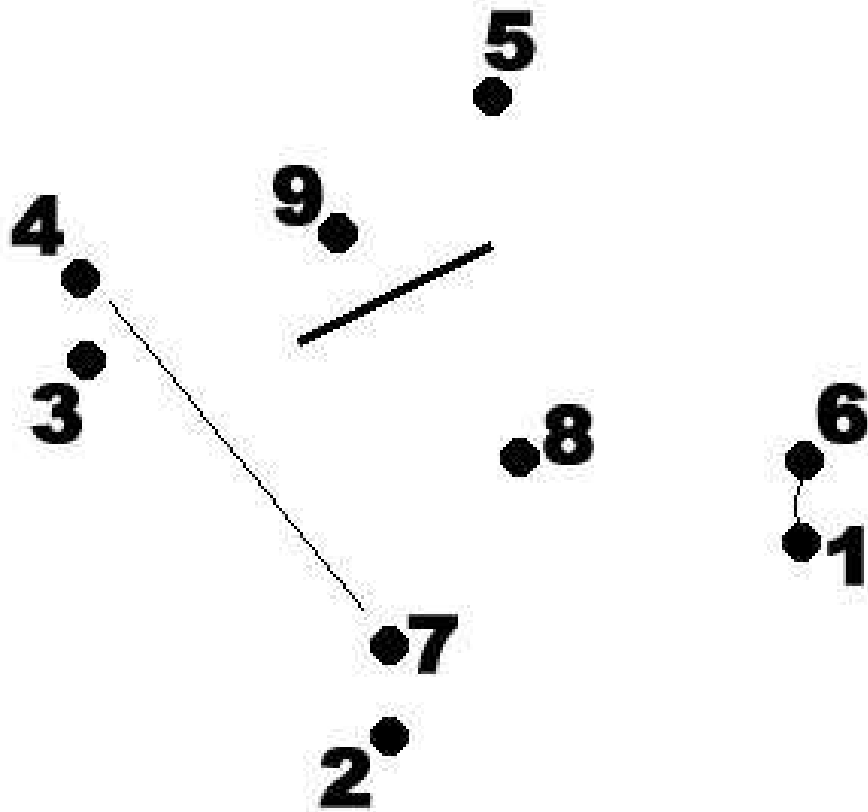


## Tuesday

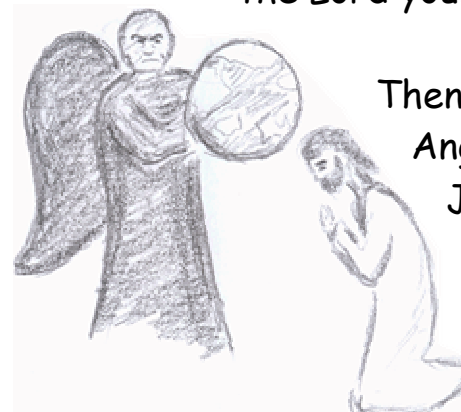
