In case you would like to do some study for yourselves; here is where this Bible story is found:




Jesus was so tired that He lay down in back of the boat and soon He was fast asleep.

All of a sudden strong winds came rushing down the hills and across the lake, and big black clouds hid the




moon and stars. There was thunder, lightening and rain, and the waves

Jesus held up His hand and said, "Peace, be still."


Just like that, the wind stopped howling, the thunder stopped roaring, and waves became gentle again.
