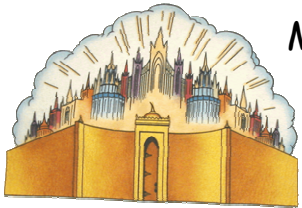
One day the disciples asked Jesus to teach them how to pray. This is the prayer that Jesus taught them.

May your Kingdom come soon.



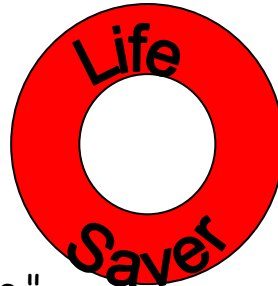
May your will be done on earth,

against us.



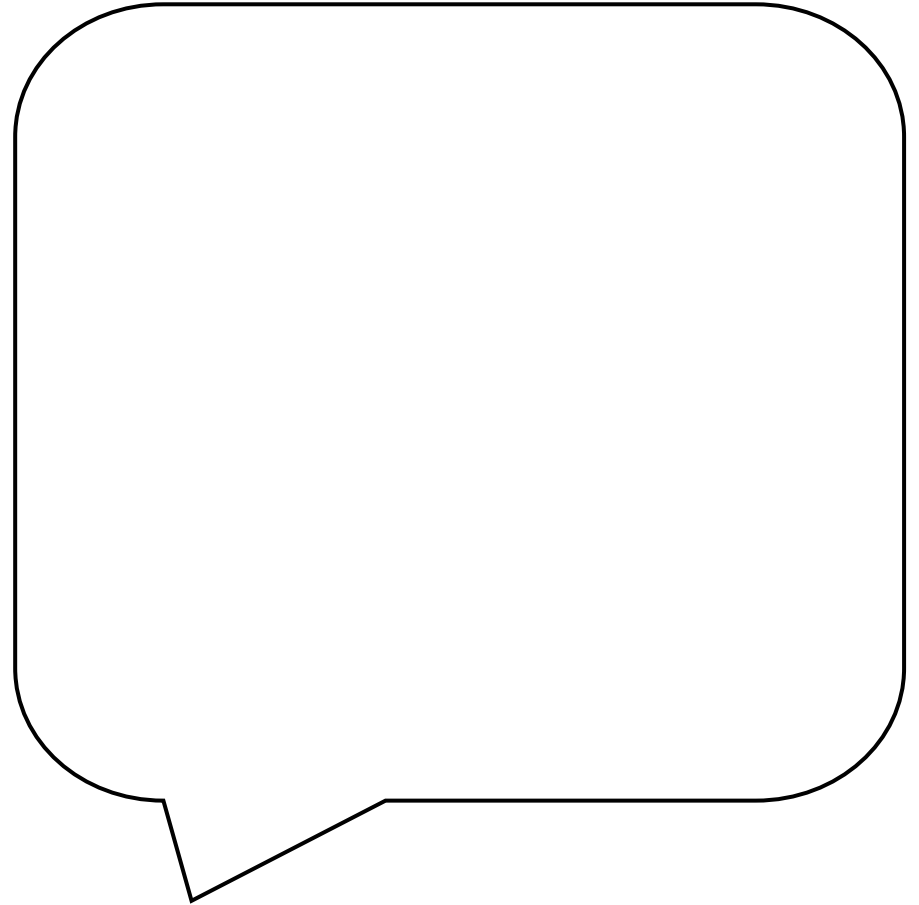

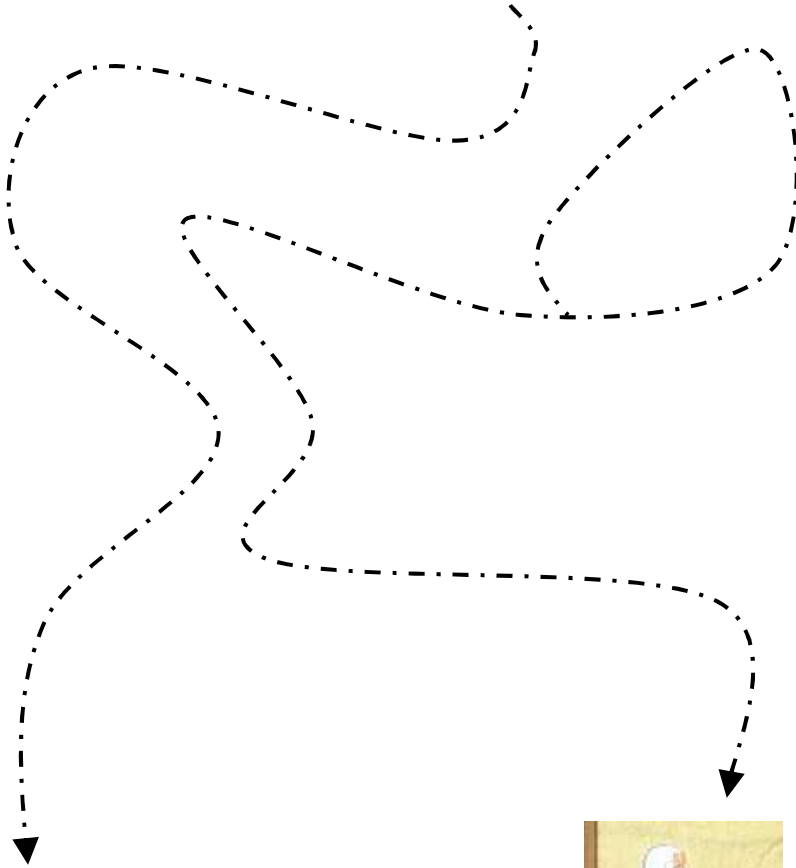
Friday

Draw what you did today and then kneel down with Mummy or Daddy and tell Jesus about it.



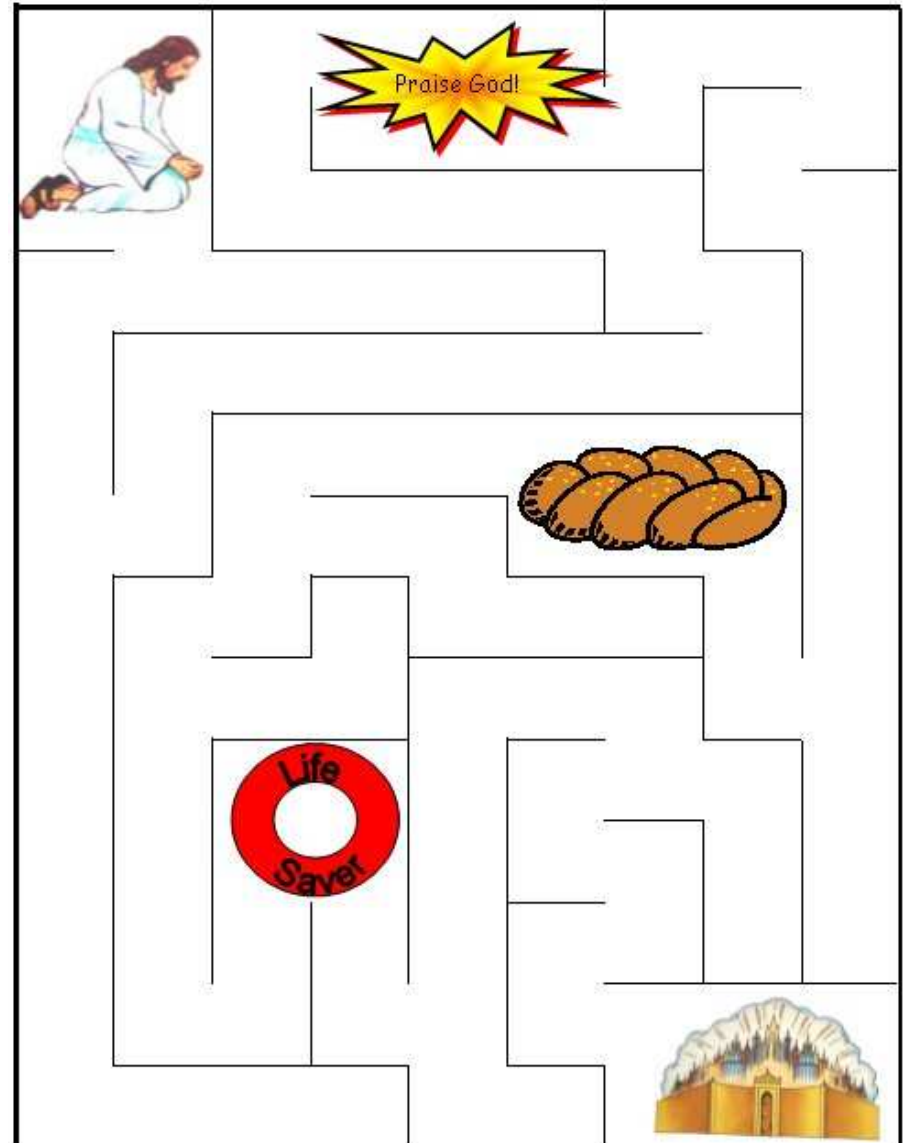
Thursday

Whose prayer pleased God? The Pharisee who thanked God that he wasn't a sinner or the tax collector who prayed because he was a sinner?



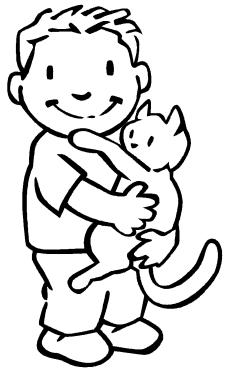
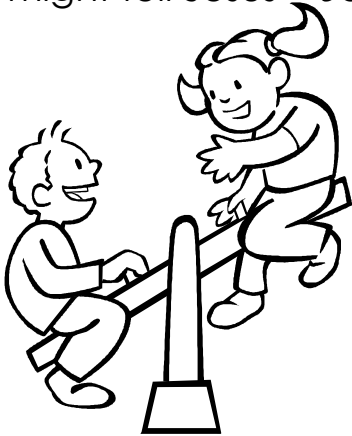
Monday

Find your way from Jesus praying to heaven to find some of the things that Jesus prayed for.



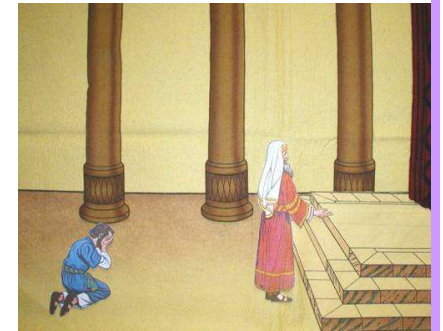
Tuesday
