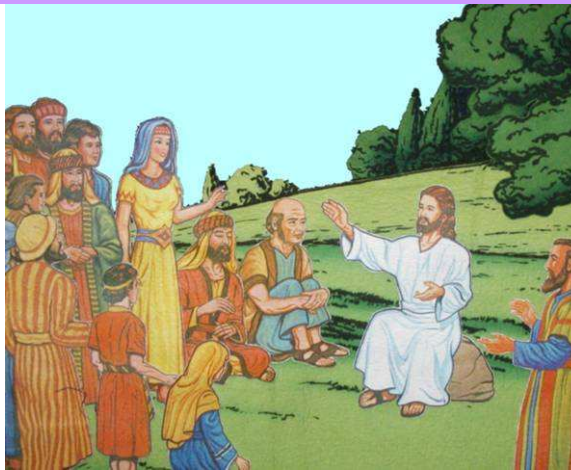

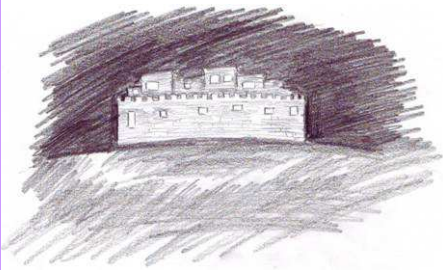
Sunday

One day Jesus sat down on a mountain and told the people some stories.

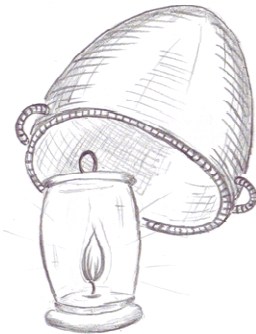
He said that God will look after people who are poor or sad or hurt.

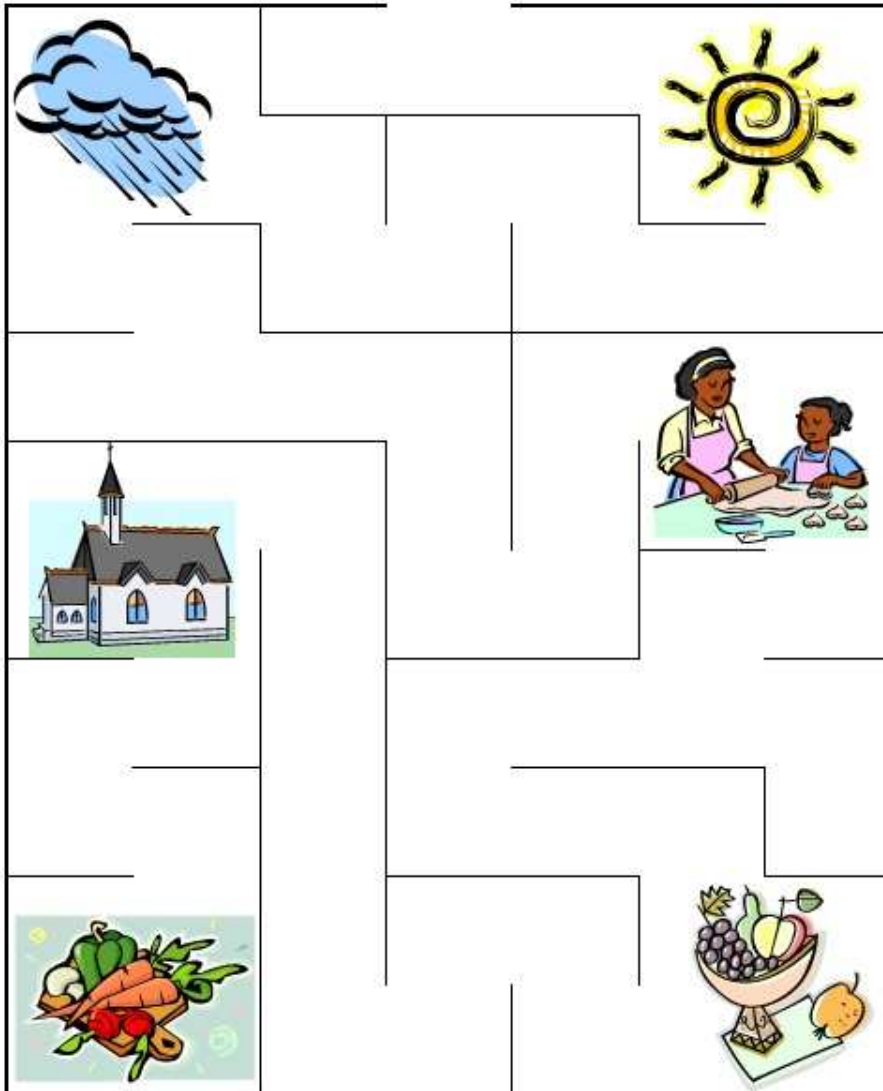
When we see the birds and flowers we should remember that Jesus cares for us.

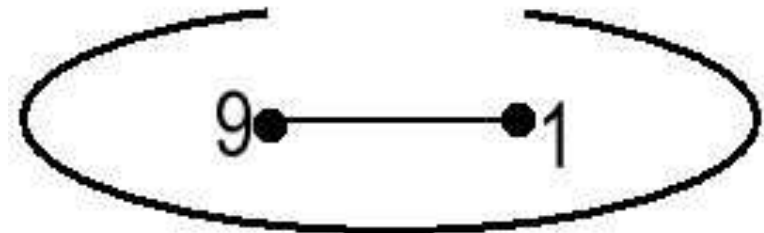
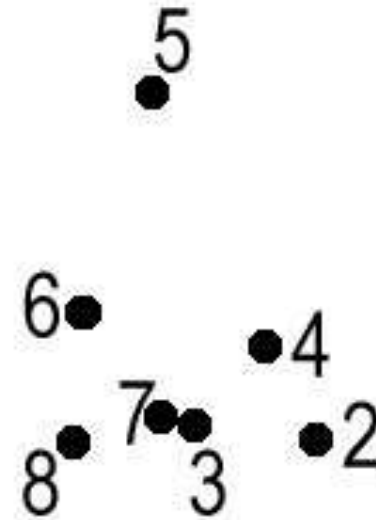
Thursday

Jesus said that God would give us the things that we need. Go through the maze to see some things that God gives us.



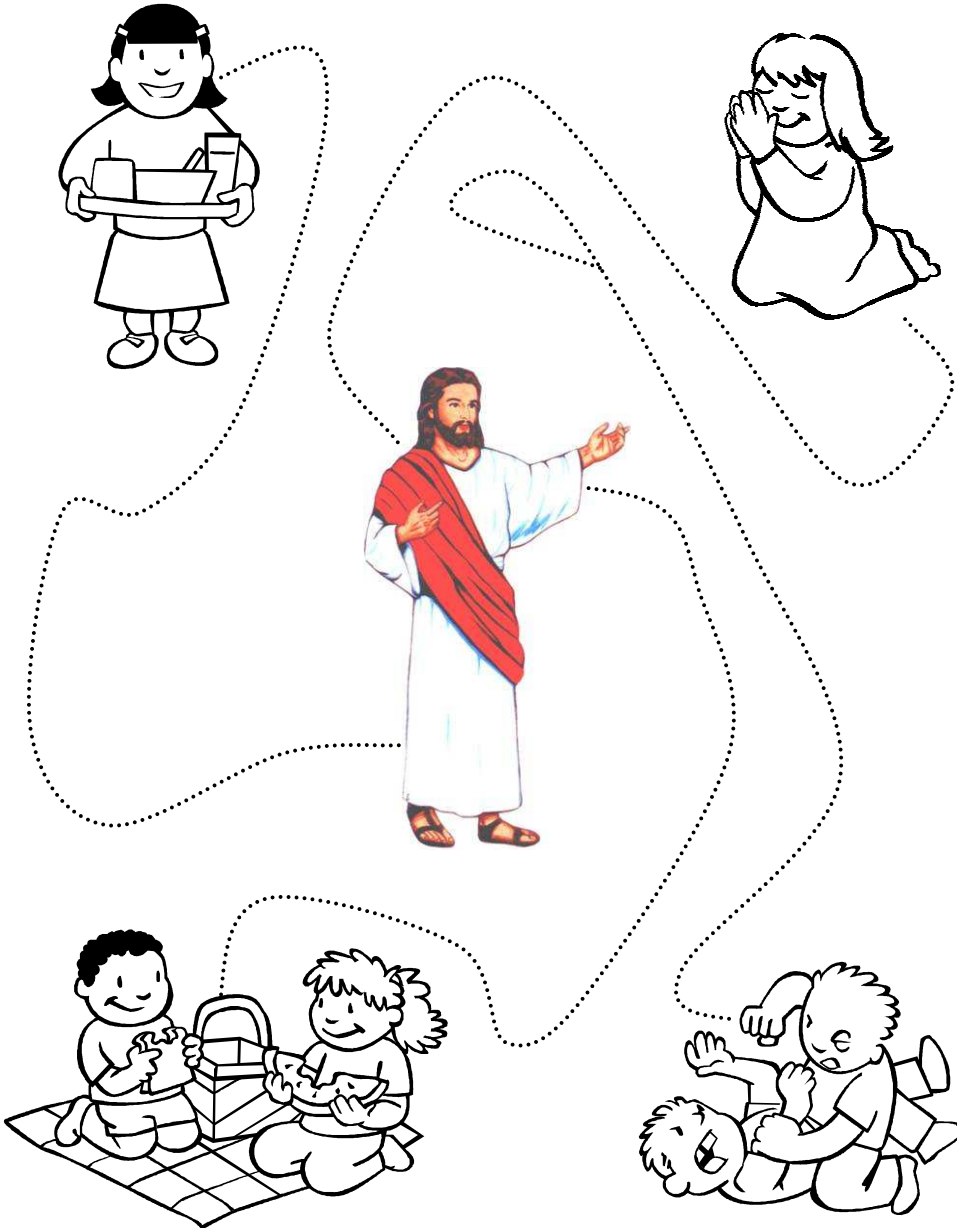
Monday

Jesus wants you to be loving and kind and happy. Follow the lines from Jesus to see what you can do.

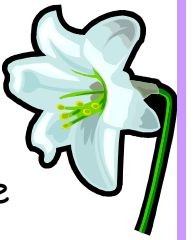


Wednesday
