
# <u>Sunday</u>

Jesus knew that in church we need to be quiet and listen so that we can hear God speaking to us.




#### **Friday**

The people, who couldn't walk, now jumped for joy, the people who had been deaf could now hear what was going on and those who were blind could now see.


The children were so happy that they sang songs to Jesus; some even sat on His lap and hugged Him.

tell the children to be quiet and not sing, but Jesus said that it is good to sing and pray in church and to praise Jesus whenever we can.




