
May God bless you as you teach your little ones about Him.


<u>Sunday</u>

<u>Friday</u>


Jesus wants you to love other people just like He did. Here are some people that you can show Jesus' love to. Colour them in.






<u>Thursday</u>

When we see the Grape Juice and the special Passover bread we should remember Jesus.




<u>Monday</u>
