
They did many things to Him, things that hurt Him very much. They beat Him, teased Him and put a crown of thorns on His head; the thorns dug into His skin and made it bleed.


All the time while this was happening Jesus never complained or said or did anything, He knew that these terrible things had to happen to Him so He could save us from our sins and so that we could go

Jesus wants us to remember what happened to Him and to love Him and have Him as our very best friend. He wants us to live like He did, doing only the right things.








### Thursday

After Jesus had died two very rich men named Joseph and Nicodemus came and carefully and gently took the body of Jesus down off the cross.



Did Jesus cry, or yell, or hit back when the bad men were hurting him? Join the arrows.




### Tuesday
