Title: An Angel opens Prison Doors.

Memory Verse: Acts 5:19 “The angel...opened the prison doors.” KJV

Lesson References: Acts 12:1-17.
The Bible Story, Vol. 10 p.57-62
Acts of the Apostles p. 143-149, 152-154
The Story of Redemption p. 292-297

Lesson Aim: When we share our knowledge of Jesus with others and live the life He wants us to then regardless of our circumstances we can know that Jesus is leading and guiding us in the way that is best for us.

Story Illustration Ideas:
